Please find attached a weekly summary of bills impacting your office. Here are some highlights from this week:

- HB1102: Prop Taxes; Abatement; Procedures was held for a second time this week in COW. Big thanks to Angela, Sarah, Cathy and Beth who spend Thursday at the capitol visiting with members and staff. AACo will continue to closely monitor the bill. We anticipate the bill will resurface on a COW calendar; however, we have worked hard to educate members. (Megan)
- SB1274 Public Monies; Recovery; Illegal Payment passed Senate Government Committee with the amendment we all agreed on. The language for indemnification was expanded per a suggestion by the League of Arizona Cities & Towns. Review here: <https://apps.azleg.gov/BillStatus/GetDocumentPdf/457353>. (Trey)
- After initially verbally stating he would hear SB1214 County Elected Official Salary Adjustment, Senator Sonny Borrelli, Chair of Senate Government, declined to place the bill on the Senate Government agenda for the last week to hear bills in committee in their chamber of origin. He cites the fiscal impact to La Paz County and other financially strained counties. Staff is working on another option in Senate Appropriations. (Trey)
