

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR MEETING HELD ON
Tuesday, February 27, 2018**

A regular board meeting of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, February 27, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, 1415 Melody Lane, Building G, Bisbee, Arizona.

CALL TO THE PUBLIC

Chairman English opened the call to the public.

No one chose to speak and Chairman English closed the call to the public.

This is the time for the public to comment. Members of the Board may not discuss items that are not specifically identified on the agenda.

PRESENTATION

Presentation by Ms. Vada Phelps, Executive Director, Arizona @ Work, Southeastern Arizona regarding the highlights of the annual plan.

Ms. Phelps went over the annual plan and thanked County staff for their support of the program. She stated that the program had clean audits and was a low risk auditee, which is good for all three County partners. She noted that once a year a strategic plan workshop was held and invited the board to attend. She said she would be reaching out to the three county managers to set up a meeting. She also shared success stories of program participants and said that she was concerned about funding, but hopes that funding will come through and appreciated the support of the County.

Chairman English said it was important for the County to support programs that help people find jobs.

The Board thanked Ms. Phelps for the presentation and update.

6. Approve demands and budget amendments for operating transfers. Warrants Nos. 23814-24104 were issued in the amount of \$843,210.36.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to approve items 1-6 on the consent agenda. Supervisor Judd seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

Board of Supervisors

7. Approve an Interim Permit/Location Transfer liquor license application for a series #6 (Bar) license submitted by Ms. Pamela Karen Cohen for The Thirsty Lizard, LLC, located at 5838 W. Double Adobe Road, Mc Neal, Arizona 85617.

Ms. Arlethe Rios, Clerk of the Board, presented this item. Ms. Rios said the Sheriff's Office did not have a recommendation and that the Planning and Zoning Department had recommended approval. The Environmental Health Division noted that they would contact the applicant regarding any permits needed for the approval of the liquor license; the Treasurer's Office noted that the property taxes are current. The Board staff recommended approval.

Chairman English opened the public hearing.

No one chose to speak and Chairman English closed the public hearing.

Supervisor Judd moved to approve an Interim Permit/Location Transfer liquor license application for a series #6 (Bar) license submitted by Ms. Pamela Karen Cohen for The Thirsty Lizard, LLC, located at 5838 W. Double Adobe Road, Mc Neal, Arizona 85617. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

Community Development

8. Adopt Zoning Ordinance 18-02 approving Docket Z-18-02 amending certain zoning district boundaries from RU-4 (rural, one dwelling per four acres) to RU-2 (rural, one dwelling per two acres), pursuant to the application of Jim Colville.

Mr. Robert Kirschmann, Planner II, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Kirschmann gave the background, showed a map and pictures of the location.

He presented the

Factors in Favor of Approval:

1. Allowing the request would be in keeping with the character of the existing development in the area and create a buffer between the small subdivision lots and larger RU-4 zoned parcels;
2. The Comprehensive Plan policies prescribe a low density of residential development in this area to protect the current character of the neighborhood, and the request would facilitate such a density; and
3. Four letters of support have been received.

Factors Against Approval:

1. A revised conceptual plan has not been provided to show how the parcels will ultimately be configured.

Mr. Kirschmann stated that based on the factors in favor of approval staff recommends conditional approval of the rezoning request, subject to the following conditions:

1. The Applicant shall provide the County with a signed Acceptance of Conditions and a Waiver of Claims form arising from ARS Section 12-1134 signed by the property owner of the subject property within thirty (30) days of Board of Supervisors approval of the rezoning; and

2. It is the Applicants' responsibility to obtain any additional permits, or meet any additional conditions, that may be applicable to the proposed use pursuant to other federal, state, or local laws or regulations; and
3. The parcel shall not be split into more than two parcels.

Vice-Chairman Call asked if it had been unanimously approved by the Planning and Zoning Commission.

Mr. Kirshmann said that it had.

Chairman English opened the public hearing.

No one chose to speak and Chairman English closed the public hearing.

Vice-Chairman moved to adopt Zoning Ordinance 18-02 approving Docket Z-18-02 amending certain zoning district boundaries from RU-4 (rural, one dwelling per four acres) to RU-2 (rural, one dwelling per two acres), pursuant to the application of Jim Colville. Supervisor Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for vote and it was approved 3-0.

9. Adopt Zoning Ordinance 18-01 approving Docket Z-18-01 amending certain zoning district boundaries from R-9 (residential; one dwelling per 9,000 square feet) to GB (general business), pursuant to the application of Maby C. Pena and Ricardo Andres Pena Cruz.

Mr. Peter Gardner, Planner I, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Gardner gave the background, showed a map of the location, and pictures of the area. He noted that there were concerns about traffic and discussed the proposed solution by showing the suggested routes for traffic.

He presented the

Factors in Favor of Approval:

1. Allowing the request would be in keeping with the character of the existing development in the area;
2. The Comprehensive Plan policies prescribe developing areas to grow towards build-out. This request would infill a large undeveloped area, indicating the direction of future development;
3. The request will continue an existing effort to replace and revitalize distressed or vacant properties with conforming development;
4. Two letters of support have been received.

Factors Against Approval:

1. The rezoning will create a land use with more neighborhood impacts than would be permitted under the existing zoning; and
2. There is a potentially unsound bridge along one potential access route to the site; and
3. Five letters of opposition have been received

Chairman English asked if the existing homes on the parcel owned by the applicant.

Mr. Gardner said that they were not and they would be removed as they were vacated.

He stated that based on the factors in favor of approval, staff recommended conditional

approval of the rezoning request, subject to the following conditions and modification:

1. The Applicant shall provide the County with a signed Acceptance of Conditions and a Waiver of Claims form arising from ARS Section 12-1134 signed by the property owner of the subject property within thirty (30) days of Board of Supervisors approval of the rezoning; and
2. It is the Applicants' responsibility to obtain any additional permits, or meet any additional conditions, that may be applicable to the proposed use pursuant to other federal, state, or local laws or regulations; and
3. The Applicant shall direct truck traffic along the route designated above.

Modification - The existing homes may maintain a ten-foot setback from property lines.

Chairman English opened the public hearing.

No one chose to speak and Chairman English closed the public hearing.

Supervisor Judd moved to adopt Zoning Ordinance 18-01 approving Docket Z-18-01 amending certain zoning district boundaries from R-9 (residential; one dwelling per 9,000 square feet) to GB (general business), pursuant to the application of Maby C. Pena and Ricardo Andres Pena Cruz. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English asked how the truck route outlined would be enforced.

Mr. Gardner said that the Sheriff's Office could handle enforcement.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

ACTION

Board of Supervisors

10. Approve license agreement between Cochise County and the City of Bisbee for use of space in the Melody Lane Complex in the amount of \$4,200 on a monthly basis until the City can move to a permanent location.

Mr. Ed Gilligan, County Administrator, presented this item. Mr. Gilligan explained the reason for the agreement and added that the agreement was designed to reimburse the County for the services provided in support of the city. He stated that based on local market value the County would be charging the city \$1/square foot for commercial space.

Vice-Chairman Call asked if the contract was open ended.

Mr. Gilligan said that the contract was open ended, but assured Vice-Chairman Call that the city was looking for other locations to permanently set up their offices.

Chairman English said that the city would need time to look at a building they would be able to afford and noted that the contract did have a 30 day notice of termination if either party wanted to cancel.

Vice-Chairman Call asked if Mr. Gilligan had any plans to move the city into a specific area of the County that could be their temporary space, but provide an individual space for them to operate out of.

Mr. Gilligan said he had entertained that idea and would be working to assess available space for discussion with the city.

Supervisor Judd asked if the compensation would date back to when the city moved into the County building.

Mr. Gilligan said it would date back to November 1, 2017.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to approve license agreement between Cochise County and the City of Bisbee for use of space in the Melody Lane Complex in the amount of \$4,200 on a monthly basis until the City can move to a permanent location. Supervisor Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

11. Approve the over-the-counter sale of tax deed properties as set forth in the attached Exhibit A, plus related administrative fees.

Ms. Rios presented this item. She said that there had been one bid received for six parcels for a total sale of \$1,077 (\$1,002 for the bid and \$75 for the administrative fees).

Vice-Chairman Call moved to approve the over-the-counter sales of tax deed properties as set forth in the attached Exhibit A, plus related administrative fees. Supervisor Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

STATE & FEDERAL LEGISLATION

12. Discussion and possible action regarding state and federal legislative matters, including but not limited to the items in the attached County Supervisors Association (CSA) Legislative Policy Committee (LPC) Agenda, the Arizona Association of Counties (AACo) Committee Agenda and the proposed State budget.

Ms. Cathy Traywick, County Treasurer and AACo representative, presented legislative proposals for AACo and noted she would be attending the National Association of Counties (NACo).

Chairman English said that the LPC had not supported a Highway User Revenue Fund (HURF) legislation due to its negative impact on larger counties as the mission of CSA was to insure all counties are treated fairly.
