

RESOLUTION 18-

PUBLIC LAND ADVISORY COMMITTEE AMENDING THE COCHISE COUNTY PUBLIC AND STATE LANDS ADVISORY COMMITTEE BY-LAWS

WHEREAS, A.R.S. § 11-802 authorizes the Board of Supervisors to plan and provide for the future growth and improvements in the County to conserve and promote the public health, safety, convenience, and general welfare; and

WHEREAS, a significant percentage of lands in Cochise County are state trust and federal public lands; and

WHEREAS, in providing consultation or coordination, the Board of Supervisors can benefit from advice, knowledge, and input of residents who are familiar with and interested in public lands issues; and

WHEREAS, the Cochise County Public and State Lands Advisory Committee was established, and by-laws approved by Resolution 07-11 on February 6, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the PLAC members met at a regular meeting on July 23, 2018, to discuss the revised PLAC by-laws and unanimously recommended approval to the Board of Supervisors to amend the by-laws.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Cochise County Board of Supervisors hereby revises the Cochise County Public and State Lands Advisory Committee by-laws, which are attached hereto as Exhibit A and adopted as a part of this Resolution. The Committee shall have the purpose, membership, and scope of responsibilities as set forth in said by-laws.
