- Pursuant to Terms and Conditions, Provision Six (6), Contract Changes; Section 6.1 Amendments, Purchase Orders and Change Orders, the Scope of Work is amended as follows by this amendment one (1)

5.15 Develop and organize a local opioid fatality review team to investigate drug overdose fatalities that have occurred in Cochise County and utilize data to identify potential risk factors for opioid overdose, recommend and establish local policies to prevent additional overdose deaths, and increase coordination between state and local agencies in the development of new substance abuse prevention projects and initiatives.

5.16 Prepare and submit a quarterly Contractor's Expenditure Report.
