Good evening! Attached is the draft Transfer Agreement between the Cochise County Flood Control District and The Nature Conservancy. This is patterned after agreements to transfer and hold grant funds that the County and TNC have entered into in the past, so I am hoping we won't have too many issues getting to a final agreement within the next week or so.
