Mr. Joaquin Solis, Floodplain Engineer, presented this item. Mr. Solis gave the background and said this contract was for further monitoring to better or fine-tune the data being collected. He explained that there would be a report compiled soon that staff would present to the Board. He added that this project would be continuous and the cost would decrease overtime.
