Incident Summary

- On or about 0615 on 9 Sept 2018 a sewer line on the Mexican side of the border burst sending HAZMAT across the international border.
- Office of Emergency Services responded along with Naco Fire Department, County Department of Public Health, Cochise County Sheriffs Office, the County Incident Support Team, County Highways, and City of Bisbee Public Works.
- Approximately 682,000 gallons released 9 September
- Approximately 432,000 gallons per day released since

Response Actions (9 Sept)

- Pre-evacuation of Naco until flow could be stopped
- Containment of HAZMAT flows in Naco residential areas / POE with dirt berms.
- Closure of Green Street
- Closure of one well
- State and Federal Notifications
- Mexico Civil Defense Notifications
- Ground water testing and treatment
- Spill pool treatment and monitoring
- Public information and land owner outreach
