

**RESOLUTION 18-18**

**DECLARING A STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY IN COCHISE COUNTY DUE TO A  
HAZARDOUS MATERIAL INCIDENT IN NACO, ARIZONA.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors, Cochise County, Arizona, is authorized to declare the existence of a local emergency when Cochise County is affected or likely to be affected by a disaster that places people or property in peril; and

**WHEREAS**, On September 9, 2018, a sewer line on Mexico's side of the border burst, sending Hazardous Material across the international border into Cochise County; and

**WHEREAS**, the hazardous material spillage has resulted in a condition of extreme peril to the health and safety of citizens in Cochise County.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Board of Supervisors does hereby declare a State of Local Emergency due to the flooding caused by the hazardous material spillage incident.
