

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR MEETING HELD ON
Tuesday, March 26, 2019**

A regular board meeting of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, March 26, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, 1415 Melody Lane, Building G, Bisbee, Arizona.

CALL TO THE PUBLIC

Chairman Judd opened the call to the public.

Mr. Thomas Davis, Hereford citizen, spoke in favor of Public Hearing item 8.

No one else chose to speak and Chairman Judd closed the call to the public.

This is the time for the public to comment. Members of the Board may not discuss items that are not specifically identified on the agenda.

4. Approve the appointment of Mr. Clint Briseno to the District 1 Board of Adjustment, for a term effective immediately through December 31, 2022.

5. Approve re-appointment of Justice Court Precinct Five Pro Tempore, Gary W. Ramaecker and the re-appointment of Gerald F. Till, Paul Julien, Nathaniel Scott Redmon, C.J. Garan, Michael Skiles and Pamela Housh as county-wide Justices of the Peace Pro Tempore for emergency or temporary coverage, both pursuant to ARS 22-121; and approve authorization to call upon an appropriately-appointed Justice of the Peace Pro Tempore from another county in extenuating circumstances pursuant to ARS 22-122 effective July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.

6. Approve demands and budget amendments for operating transfers. Warrants Nos. 32577-32874 were issued in the amount of \$1,524,560.60.

Supervisor English moved to approve items 1-6 on the consent agenda. Chairman Judd seconded the motion and it was approved unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

Community Development

7. Adopt Resolution 19-03 to drop 3.96 miles of Duquesne Road from the County Maintenance System and adopt Resolution 19-04 to add 1 mile of Kings Ranch Road to the County Maintenance System.

Ms. Teresa Murphy, Right-of-Way Agent, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. She showed the location of the two roads; their county maintained history and current status; and funding allocation. Ms. Murphy answered questions from Vice-Chairman English regarding the forest road status of Duquesne Road.

Chairman Judd opened the public hearing.

No one chose to speak and Chairman Judd closed the public hearing.

Vice-Chairman English moved to adopt Resolution 19-03 to drop 3.96 miles of Duquesne Road from the County Maintenance System and adopt Resolution 19-04 to add 1 mile of Kings Ranch Road to the County Maintenance System. Chairman Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman Judd called for the vote and it was approved 2-0-1 (Borer absent).

8. Adopt Resolution 19-05 Establishing Kings Ranch Road as a Declared County Highway.

Ms. Teresa Murphy, Right-of-Way Agent, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. She said this was the second part of the public/private partnership program.

Chairman Judd opened the public hearing.

No one chose to speak and Chairman Judd closed the public hearing.

Vice-Chairman English moved to adopt Resolution 19-05 Establishing Kings Ranch Road as a Declared County Highway. Chairman Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman Judd called for the vote and it was approved 2-0-1 (Borer absent).

ACTION

Court Administration

9. Approve the appointment of Candyce Pardee to serve as Superior Court Pro Tempore, on a part-time basis pursuant to ARS 12-141 and ARS 8-231 and authorize Court Administration to call upon an appropriate appointed Superior Court Judge Pro Tempore from another county in extenuating circumstances pursuant to ARS 12-144, effective March 26, 2019 through June 30, 2019 and from July 1, 2019 through June 20, 2020.

Speaking on behalf of Mr. Eric Silverberg, Ms. Tracey Romero, introduced Ms. Candyce Pardee.

Ms. Candyce Pardee said she was delighted for the opportunity to work with the Drug Court team.

Chairman Judd and Vice-Chairman English thanked Ms. Pardee for her willingness to serve.

Vice-Chairman English made a motion to approve the appointment of Candyce Pardee to serve as Superior Court Pro Tempore, on a part-time basis pursuant to ARS 12-141 and ARS 8-231 and authorize Court Administration to call upon an appropriate appointed Superior Court Judge Pro Tempore from another county in extenuating circumstances pursuant to ARS 12-144, effective March 26, 2019 through June 30, 2019 and from July 1, 2019 through June 20, 2020. Chairman Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman Judd called for the vote and it was approved 2-0-1 (Borer absent).

Community Development

10. Approve to release a hazard abatement lien on real property by Richard T. Bosma, property owner of parcel number 106-21-182, 134 E Via Chica, Huachuca City.

This item was presented by Daniel Coxworth, Development Services Director. Mr. Coxworth gave the background of the lien from a code violation placed on the property for a previous owner. The current owner, Mr. Bosma has made substantial improvements to the property.

Mr. Bosma addressed the Board and presented photos of the improvements made.

The Board thanked Mr. Bosma.

Vice-Chairman English moved to approve the release of a hazard abatement lien on real property by Richard T. Bosma, property owner of parcel number 106-21-182, 134 E Via Chica, Huachuca City. Chairman Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman Judd called for the vote and it was approved 2-0-1 (Borer absent).

County Sheriff

11. Approve an agreement between Cochise County and Axon Enterprise Incorporated to provide body cameras, tasers, and related equipment effective April 15, 2019 through April 15, 2024 in the amount of \$580,784.58 to be paid over a five year period.

This item was presented by Lieutenant Rich Morales, County Sheriff's Office. Lt. Morales said the contract will provide 65 body-worn cameras for patrol personnel and K-9 officers in the field; software; and unlimited cloud-based data storage. Also, 119 X2 tasers for sworn and detention personnel with a 5-year warranty, including two additional upgrades.

Vice-Chairman English asked about a protocol or policy for guidance in wearing the body cameras.

Lt. Morales said they are still developing the policy but all the patrol personnel will be expected to wear the body cameras when they are in contact with the public.

Mr. Hanson said he has had several conversations with the Sheriff's Office regarding everyone's protection and Lt. Morales said there will be a policy enacted.

Vice-Chairman English moved to approve an agreement between Cochise County and Axon Enterprise Incorporated to provide body cameras, tasers, and related equipment effective April 15, 2019 through April 15, 2024 in the amount of \$580,784.58 to be paid over a five year period. Chairman Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman Judd called for the vote and it was approved 2-0-1 (Borer absent).

Elections

12. Adopt Resolution 19-06 to approve the Vote Centers for the 2020 Presidential Preference, Primary and General Elections as listed on the attached Exhibit; and authorize the Elections Director to make substitutions as necessary prior to each election, in the event that a Vote Center replacement needs to be made in accordance with A.R.S. 16-411.

Ms. Lisa Marra, Elections Director, presented this item. Ms. Marra said there had been no substantial change to the vote centers and associated facilities lease agreement already approved. There will be at least three statewide elections in 2020. She gave the background of the use of vote centers and early voting statistics and how data is collected and will be used in the future. Based on previous work sessions and research, the current vote center list is appropriate to accommodate future elections.

Vice-Chairman English moved to adopt Resolution 19-06 to approve the Vote Centers for the 2020 Presidential Preference, Primary and General Elections as listed on the attached Exhibit; and authorize the Elections Director to make substitutions as necessary prior to each election, in the event that a Vote Center replacement needs to be made in accordance with A.R.S. 16-411. Chairman Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman Judd called for the vote and it was approved 2-0-1 (Borer absent).

Housing Authority

13. Approve the Renewal Family Self-Sufficiency Grant FSS18AZ2395-01-00 awarded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to the Housing Authority of Cochise County, in the amount of \$53,420, effective February 19, 2019 through February 18, 2020.

Ms. Anita Baca, Housing Authority Director presented this item. Ms. Baca gave the background of what the grant covers and how the Housing Authority administers the program within a five year period. Ms. Baca answered questions from the Board and gave examples of success stories.

Vice-Chairman English moved to approve the Renewal Family Self-Sufficiency Grant FSS18AZ2395-01-00 awarded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to the Housing Authority of Cochise County, in the amount of \$53,420, effective February 19, 2019 through February 18, 2020. Chairman Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman Judd called for the vote and it was approved 2-0-1 (Borer absent).

14. Adopt Resolution 19-07 to approve AZ034 Streamlined Annual and Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher Administrative Plans for Fiscal Year 2019.

Ms. Anita Baca, Housing Authority Director presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Ms. Baca gave the background of the wait list for vouchers, housing seminars and outreach programs. There are no project based vouchers in the plan and no findings in the most recent audit. Ms. Baca discussed the details of certification approval for State Consolidated Plans and expansion of existing programs and seminars.

Vice-Chairman English moved to adopt Resolution 19-07 to approve AZ034 Streamlined Annual and Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher Administrative Plans for Fiscal Year 2019. Chairman Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman Judd called for the vote and it was approved 2-0-1 (Borer absent).

STATE & FEDERAL LEGISLATION

15. Discussion and possible action regarding state and federal legislative matters listed or described in the attached County Supervisors Association Legislative Policy Committee Agenda, the Arizona Association of Counties (AACo) Legislative Policy Committee Agenda, and the proposed State budget, and other matters related thereto.

Chairman Judd asked for Vice-Chairman English's input as the County representative.

Vice-Chairman English asked that the Board be prepared to take action if necessary as legislation is amended. The Elected Officials Retirement Plan (EORP) subsidy is still working through the approval process and she will be monitoring it and other important bills.

REPORT BY EDWARD T. GILLIGAN COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR -- RECENT AND PENDING COUNTY MATTERS

Mr. Gilligan stated the Human Resources recruitment has been closed and a Director will be starting in the near future. The Facilities Director recruitment will be finalized by the beginning of the fiscal year if qualified applicants are received. The County Supervisors Association's (CSA) held their first planning meeting for the Sun Corridor Trail network linking cities to town from Las Vegas, NV to Douglas, AZ. He will bring more details to the Board as that project progresses.

Supervisor Borer was absent.

Report by District 2 Supervisor, Ann English

Supervisor English said she was sorry Supervisor Borer could not attend because of health related issues. There was a fundraiser for ASU recently held at the Douglas Regional Service Center with wine provided by Cochise County and Mexico wine growers.

Report by District 3 Supervisor, Peggy Judd

Supervisor Judd attended a check presentation by Kinder-Morgan in Willcox for the addition of road signs in the community to help visitors find Willcox wine tasting room. She said there is a healthy communities committee working to promote better eating habits and exercise in Cochise County. She will be attending a Bowie community meeting tomorrow and the Census 2020 committee next week.
