

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR MEETING HELD ON
Tuesday, May 7, 2019**

A regular board meeting of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, May 7, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, 1415 Melody Lane, Building G, Bisbee, Arizona.

CALL TO THE PUBLIC

Chairman Judd opened the call to the public.

Ms. Jere Fredenburgh, Sierra Vista resident, addressed the Board regarding the proposed County Animal Shelter.

No one else chose to speak and Chairman Judd closed the call to the public.

This is the time for the public to comment. Members of the Board may not discuss items that are not specifically identified on the agenda.

CONSENT

Board of Supervisors

1. Approve the Minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of April 23, 2019.
2. Approve letter to Freeport McMoran requesting to either purchase, enter into a long term lease, or accept donation of seven acres from Freeport property parcel number 61105141A to Cochise County for the development of a County Animal Care Center.

County Attorney

3. Approve the proposed settlement of the Small Tax Appeal in Sun Canyon Hotel Partners, LLC v. Cochise County, ST2018-000278, now pending in Arizona Tax Court, a division of the Superior Court of and for Maricopa County.

Information Technology

5. Approve Communications Use Lease Agreement Amendment AZA-006237 between the United States Department of the Interior Bureau of Land Management and Cochise County, to have a fence installed on the perimeter of the communication site and other security measures detailed in the agreement, effective March 29, 2019 through February 28, 2022.

Vice-Chairman English moved to approve items 1-5 on the consent agenda. Chairman Judd seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

Community Development

6. Approve a Substitution and Extension of the Assurance Agreement for Rolling Hills Subdivision with Pioneer Title Agency, Inc as Trustee under Trust No. 70902658, through April 30, 2022.

Mr. Robert Kirschmann, Planner II, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Kirschmann went over the request and background:

- The Rolling Hills Subdivision consists of 61 lots that are 36,000 square feet or greater.
- Zoned SM-36 which is to be developed in five phases and is located on Mescal Road, 3/4 mile north of Interstate 10.
- The Board of Supervisors approved the Final Plat in 2003. An extension to the Assurance Agreement was approved in 2006, expiring in 2014. The request before the Board now is for a total of 8 years, bringing the assurance agreement current and expiring on April 30, 2022.
- The applicant is requesting an extension until April 2022, a total of eight years including the five years that have lapsed.

Mr. Kirshmann showed a map and pictures of the location and went over the factors in favor:

1. 50% of the lots have been released.
2. The Developer has been actively discussing the remainder of the improvements in the

sub-division with County Engineering Staff.

3. Staff recommends approval of the waiver of time limits for development from three years to eight, including five years lapsed.

Chairman Judd opened the Public Hearing.

No one chose to speak and Chairman Judd closed the Public Hearing.

Vice-Chairman English moved to approve a Substitution and Extension of the Assurance Agreement for Rolling Hills Subdivision with Pioneer Title Agency, Inc as Trustee under Trust No. 70902658, through April 30, 2022. Chairman Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman Judd called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

7. Adopt Zoning Ordinance 19-03, amending certain Zoning district boundaries from R-36 (Residential; one dwelling per 36,000 square feet) to RU-4 (Rural; one dwelling per 4 acres), pursuant to the application of Alexander Aunon and Greg Stotts.

Mr. Peter Gardner, Planner II, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation.

Mr. Gardner went over the background:

- The Applicants, Alexander Aunon and Greg Stotts, are requesting rezoning from R-36 (Residential; one dwelling per 36,000 square feet) to RU-4 (Rural; one dwelling per four acres) on parcels totaling 22.08 acres east of Sunizona.
- The parcels, 401-17-206A, -206B, & -207A, are located north of the failed Sunizona Acres #3 subdivision. This subdivision is zoned R-36, as the lots are one acre. The applicants' parcels, being nearby, was also zoned R-36 in 1975, despite being larger.
- The request for a rezoning from R-36 to RU-4 is to facilitate use of the Owner Builder Opt-Out program and preserve the open space.

Mr. Gardner showed a map and pictures of the location and went over the factors in favor:

1. Allowing the request would be in keeping with the character of the existing development in the area;
2. The Comprehensive Plan policies prescribe a low density of residential development in this area to protect the current character of the neighborhood, and the request would facilitate such a density; and
3. One letter of support has been received.

Mr. Gardner stated that there were no factors against approval.

Mr. Gardner added that based on the factors in favor of approval, staff recommends Conditional Approval of the Rezoning request, subject to the following Conditions:

1. The Applicant shall provide the County with a signed Acceptance of Conditions and Waiver of Claims form arising from ARS Section 12-1134 signed by the property owner of the subject property within thirty (30) days of Board of Supervisors approval of the rezoning; and
2. It is the Applicants' responsibility to obtain any additional permits, or meet any additional conditions, that may be applicable to the proposed use pursuant to other federal, state, or local laws or regulations.

Chairman Judd opened the Public Hearing.

No one chose to speak and Chairman Judd closed the Public Hearing.

Vice-Chairman English moved to adopt Zoning Ordinance 19-03, amending certain Zoning district boundaries from R-36 (Residential; one dwelling per 36,000 square feet) to RU-4 (Rural; one dwelling per 4 acres), pursuant to the application of Alexander Aunon and Greg Stotts. Chairman Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman Judd called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

ACTION

Community Development

8. Approve Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the City of Douglas to provide Planning Services including assistance with annexations, commercial and residential development, and general plan and zoning regulations updates, in the amount of \$75 dollars per hour, billed on a monthly basis, effective immediately.

Mr. Daniel Coxworth, Development Services Director, presented this item. Mr. Coxworth stated that the resources are available and in the event that the circumstances would change, Douglas would be notified as stated in the agreement.

Vice-Chairman English moved to approve Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the City of Douglas to provide Planning Services including assistance with annexations, commercial and residential development, and general plan and zoning regulations updates, in the amount of \$75 dollars per hour, billed on a monthly basis, effective immediately. Chairman Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman Judd called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

Health & Social Services

9. Approve Amendment #3 for contract ADHS15-096693 Health Start Program between the Arizona Department of Health Services and Cochise Health & Social Services (CHSS), in the annual amount of \$306,185, to extend the contract period one year through June 30, 2020.

Ms. Judy Gilligan, Prevention Services Manager, presented this item. Ms. Gilligan gave a brief background; stated that the purpose of this amendment would be an extension of the term period; and described specific program details.

Ms. Gilligan stated that the Cochise Health and Social Services (CHSS) has received the Health Start grant for the past 26 years which allows them to promote healthy births and healthy families among Cochise County residents. The Health Start Program serves pregnant women and families with children under age two. The purpose is to reduce pregnancy and post-partum risks through a community health worker model where trained community members act as a guide and mentor using an evidence-based curriculum called "Partners for a Healthy Baby" to support and educate parents about how to raise healthy children. Pregnant women and parents receive guidance and information including what to expect during pregnancy, breastfeeding education and support, nutrition for children and pregnant women, screening for child development, activities to support healthy development and home health and safety.

Ms. Gilligan showed a video on You Tube titled "Health Start Program" in which participants of the program talk about the value the program has had for them and their families.

Chairman English asked Ms. Gilligan how many employees are a part of this program and stated that it is a great program.

Ms. Gilligan said there are six employees working this program, one full time supervisor and five Community Health workers.

Vice-Chairman English moved to approve Amendment #3 for contract ADHS15-096693 Health Start Program between the Arizona Department of Health Services and Cochise Health & Social Services (CHSS), in the annual amount of \$306,185, to extend the contract period one year through June 30, 2020. Chairman Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman Judd called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.
