Organization Relocation Purpose

- Increase Security
 - Consolidate court service to buildings that have Court Security already in place
 - Old High school
- Increase Efficiencies
 - Align departments that work together in the same building or near other critical departments
 - BOS, HR, Finance
 - Community Development, Highways, and Floodplain and Engineering
 - Legal Defender, Public Defender and Legal Advocate
 - Adult and Juvenile Detention next to the court house
 - Public Fiduciary and Health Department.
- Improve work place environment
 - Public Fiduciary controlled house hold items are currently stored in offices and the health department recommends these are stored outside office workspaces
- Maximize the available County space
- Empty the Old Highschool in Bisbee

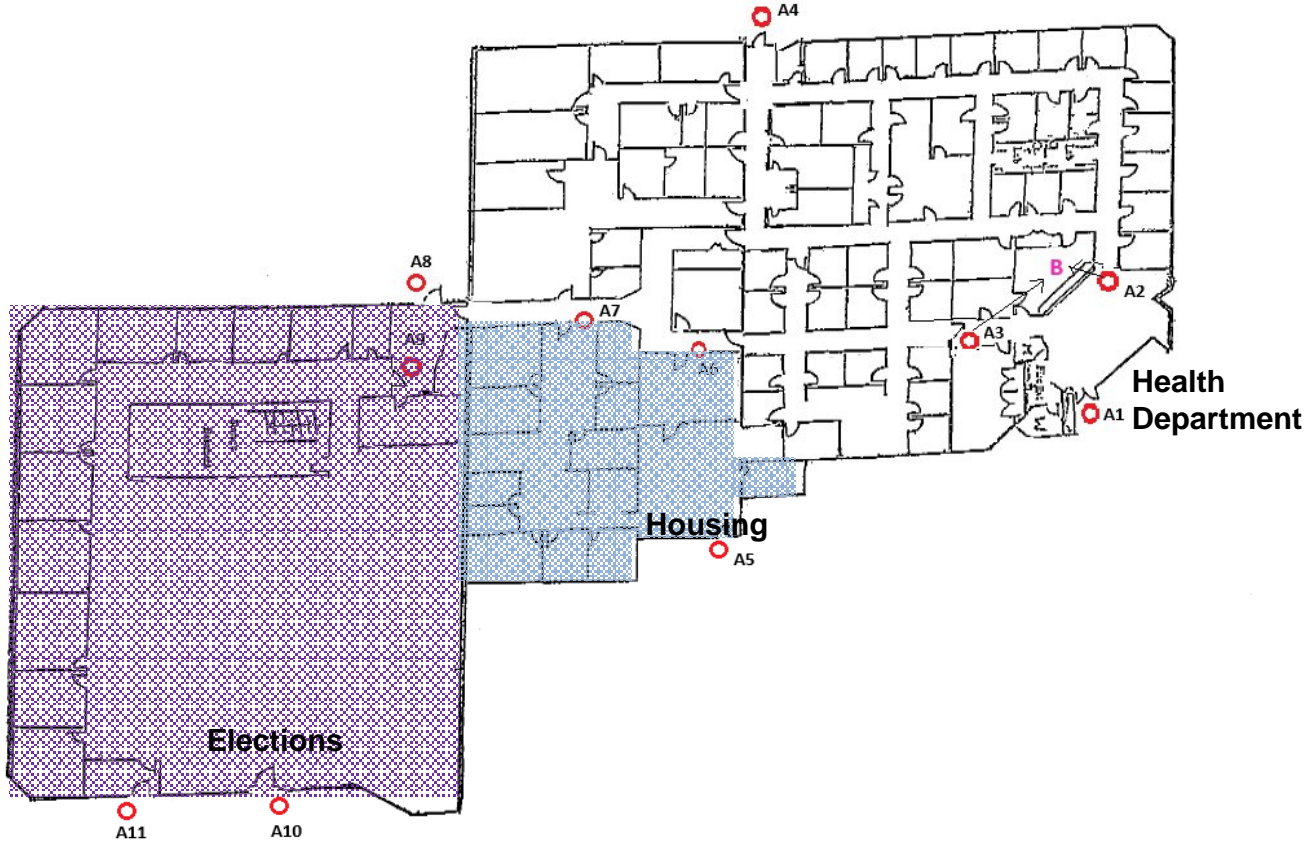

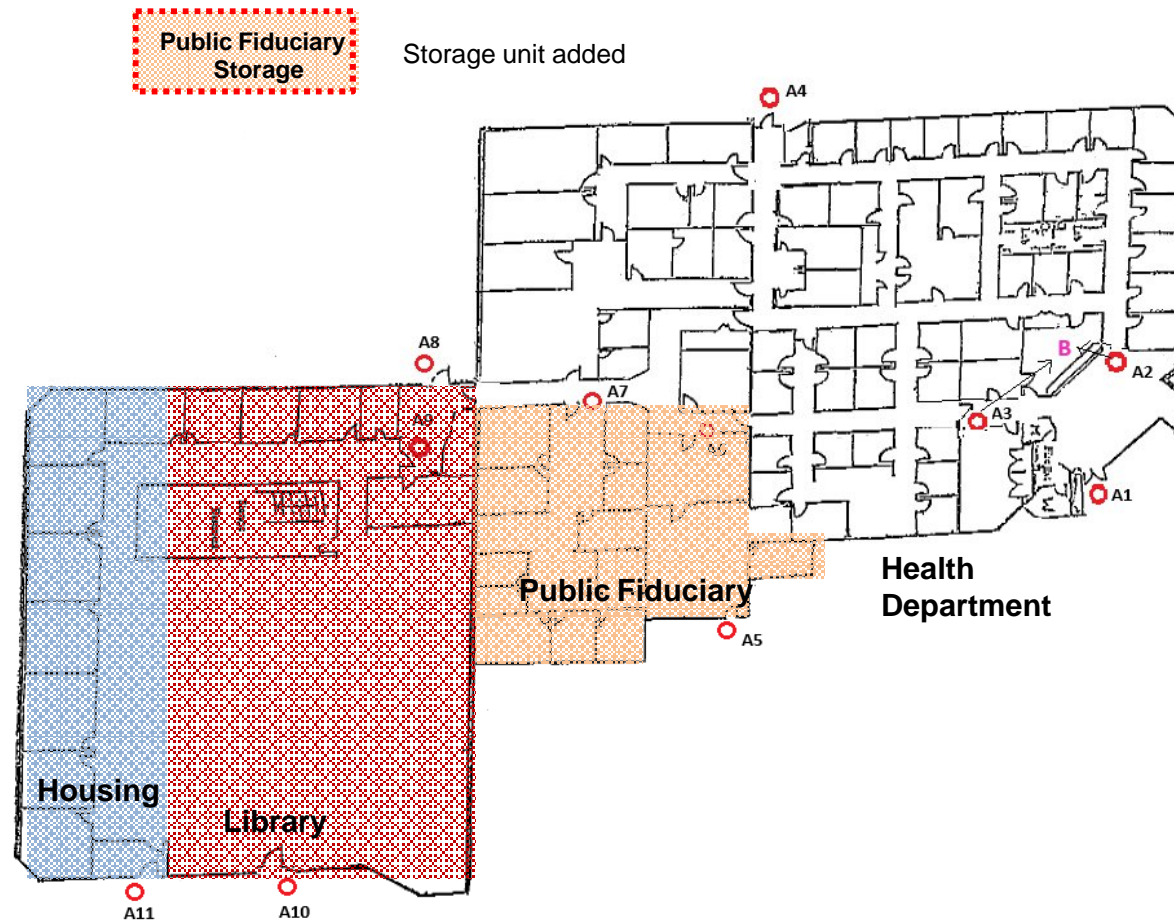

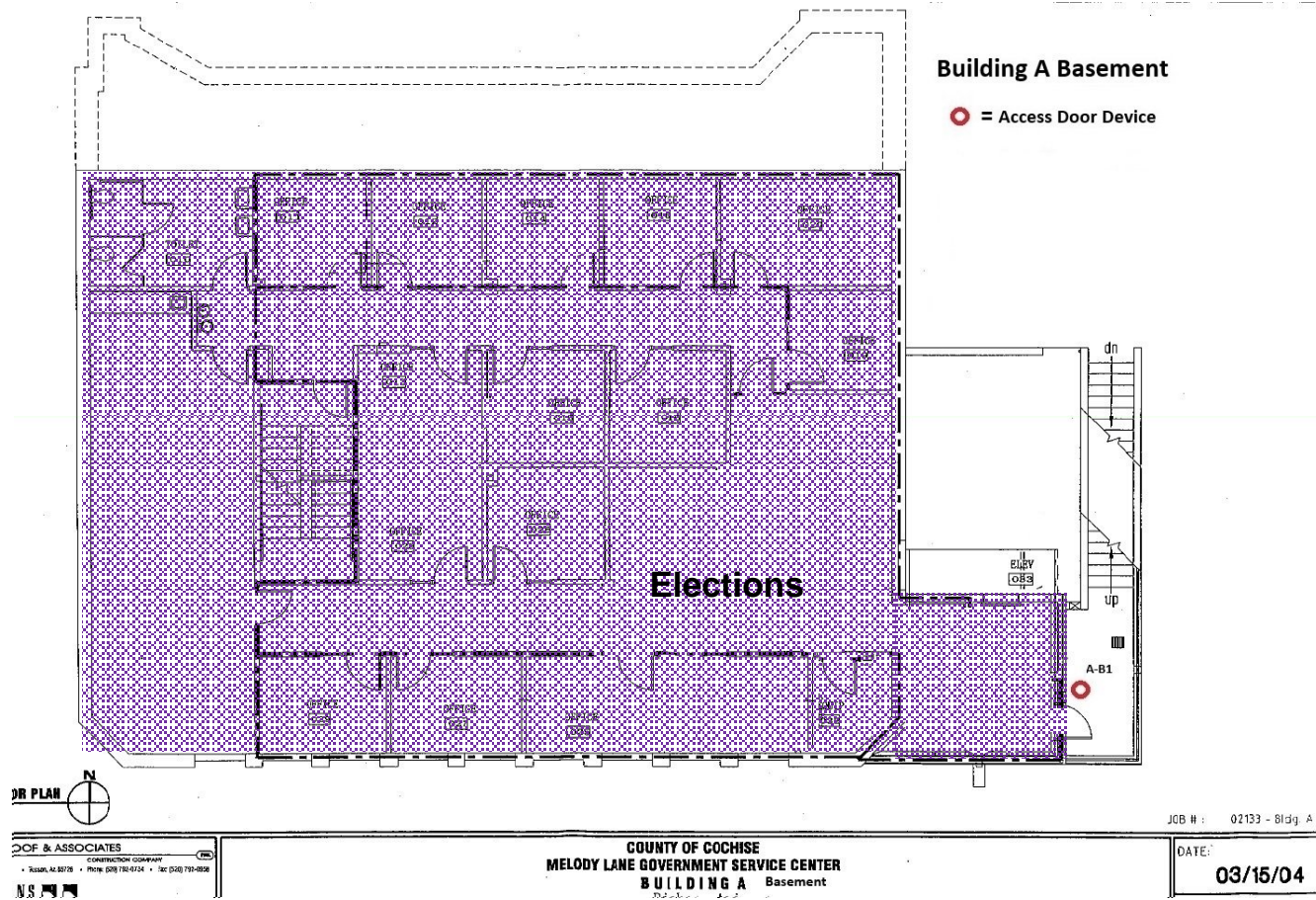

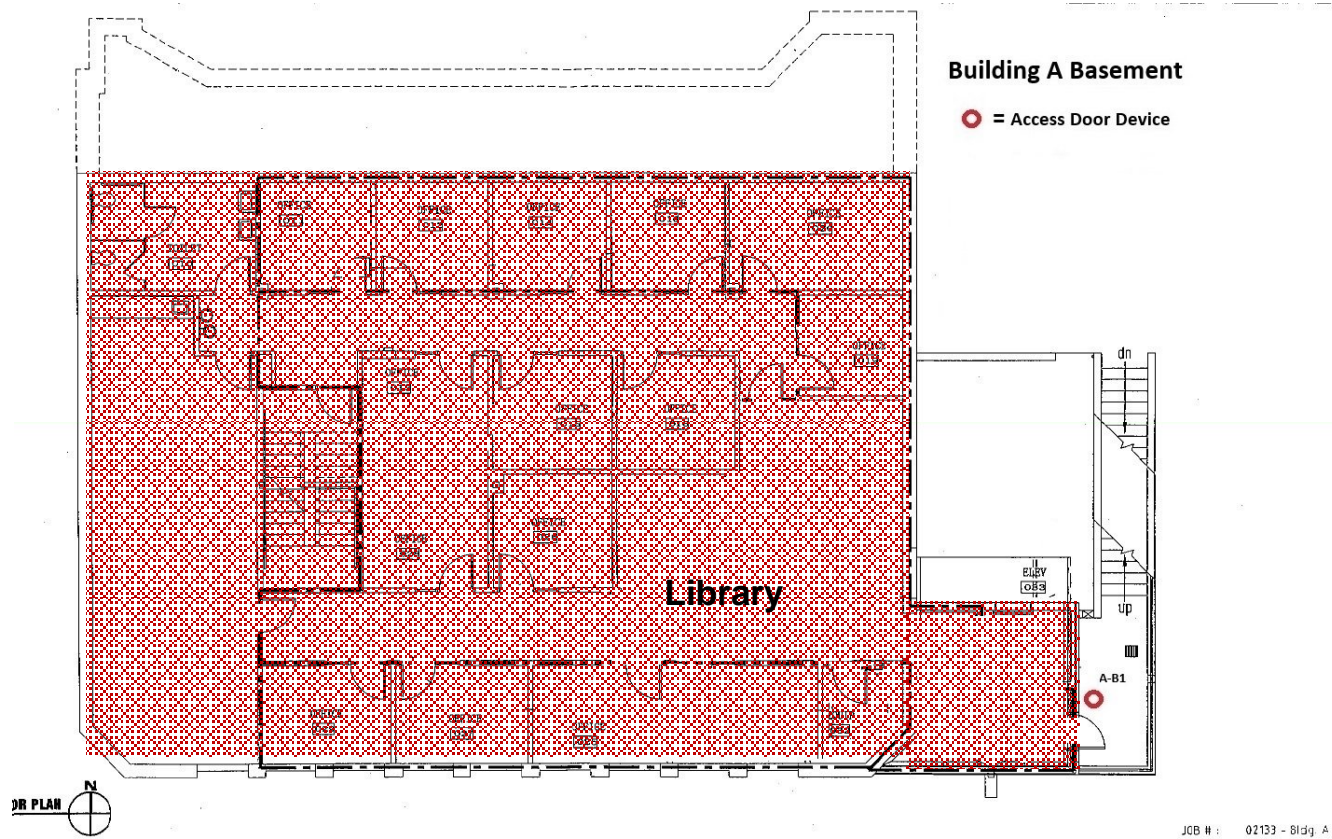

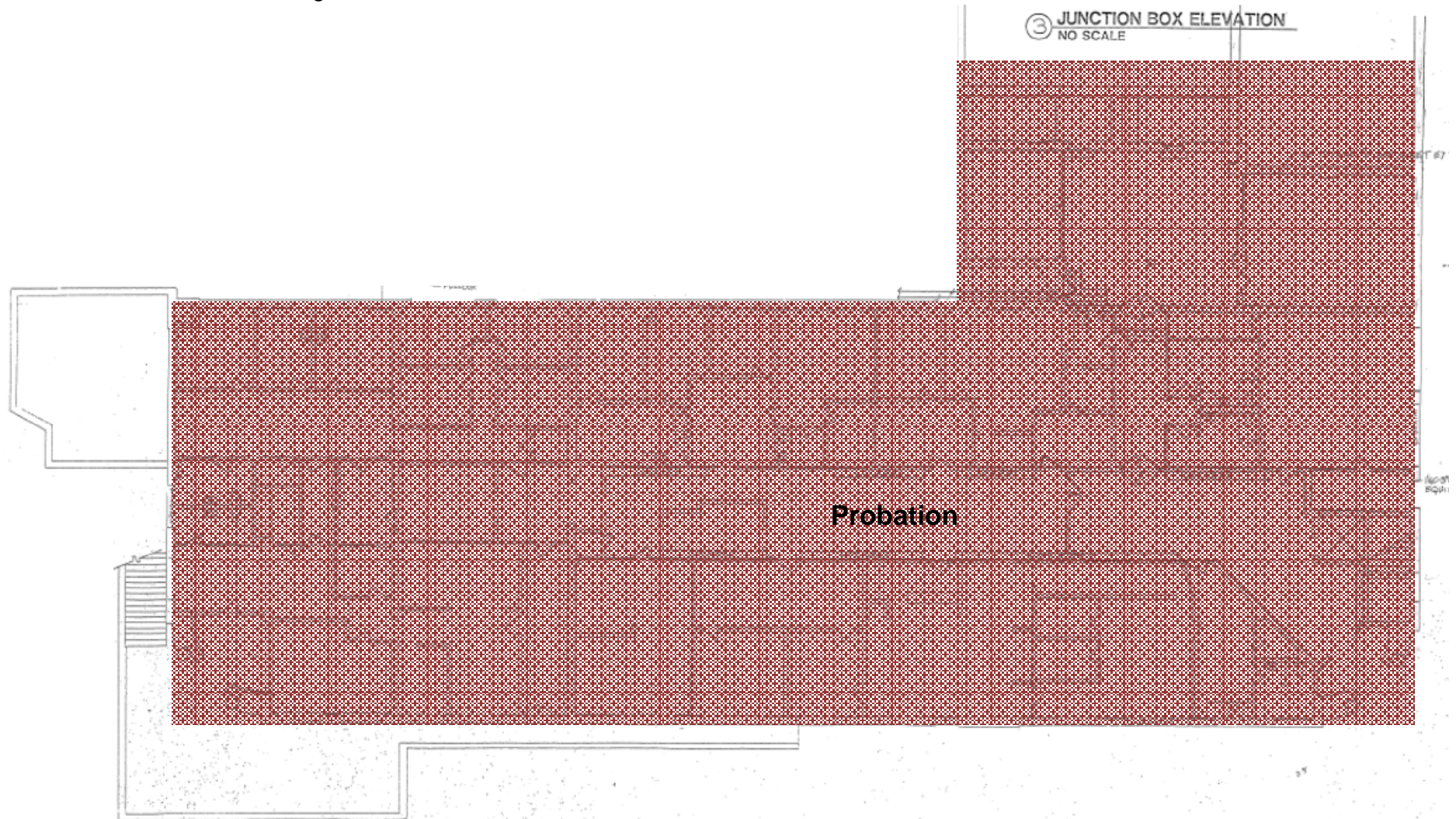

1st Floor Old High School

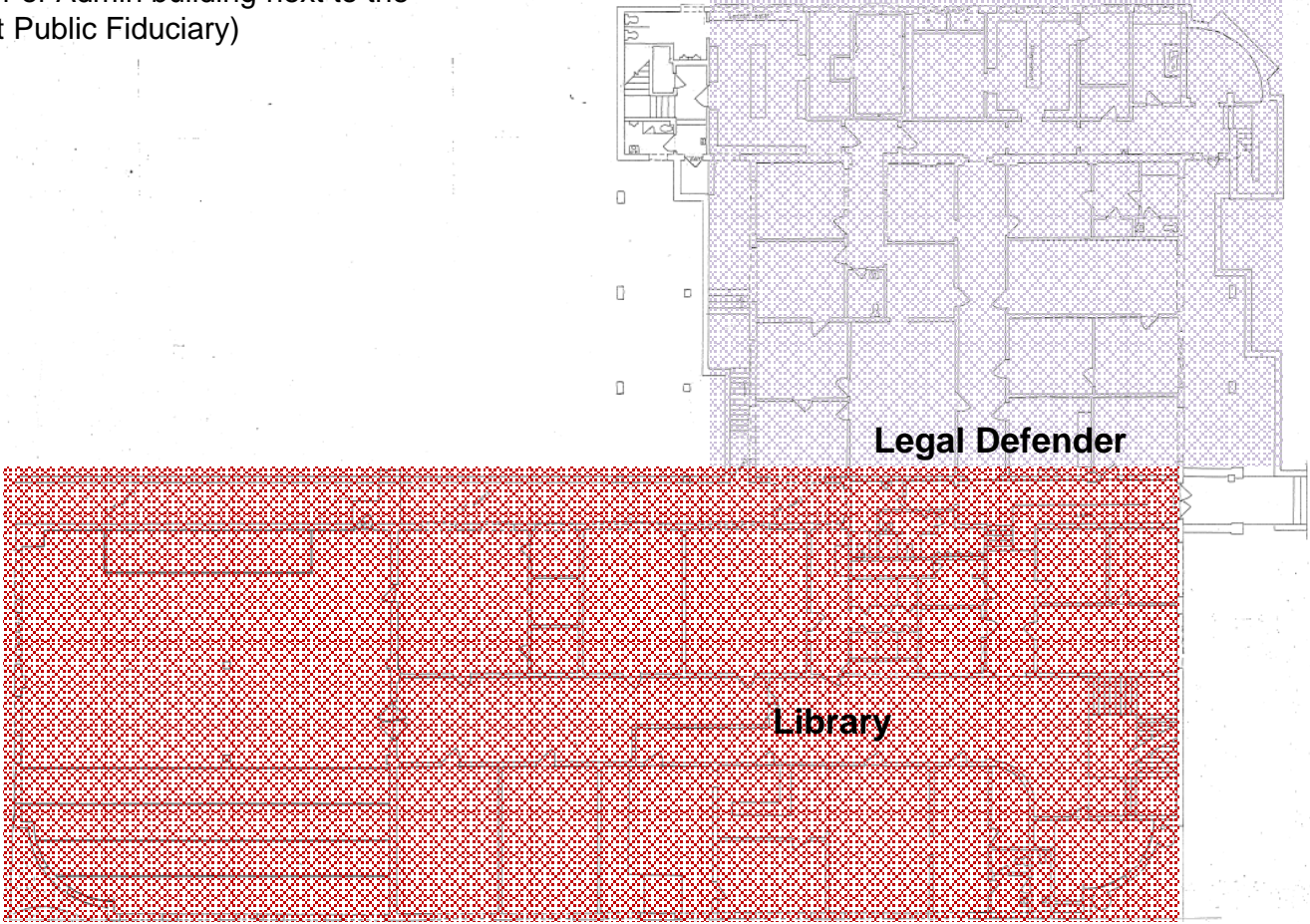

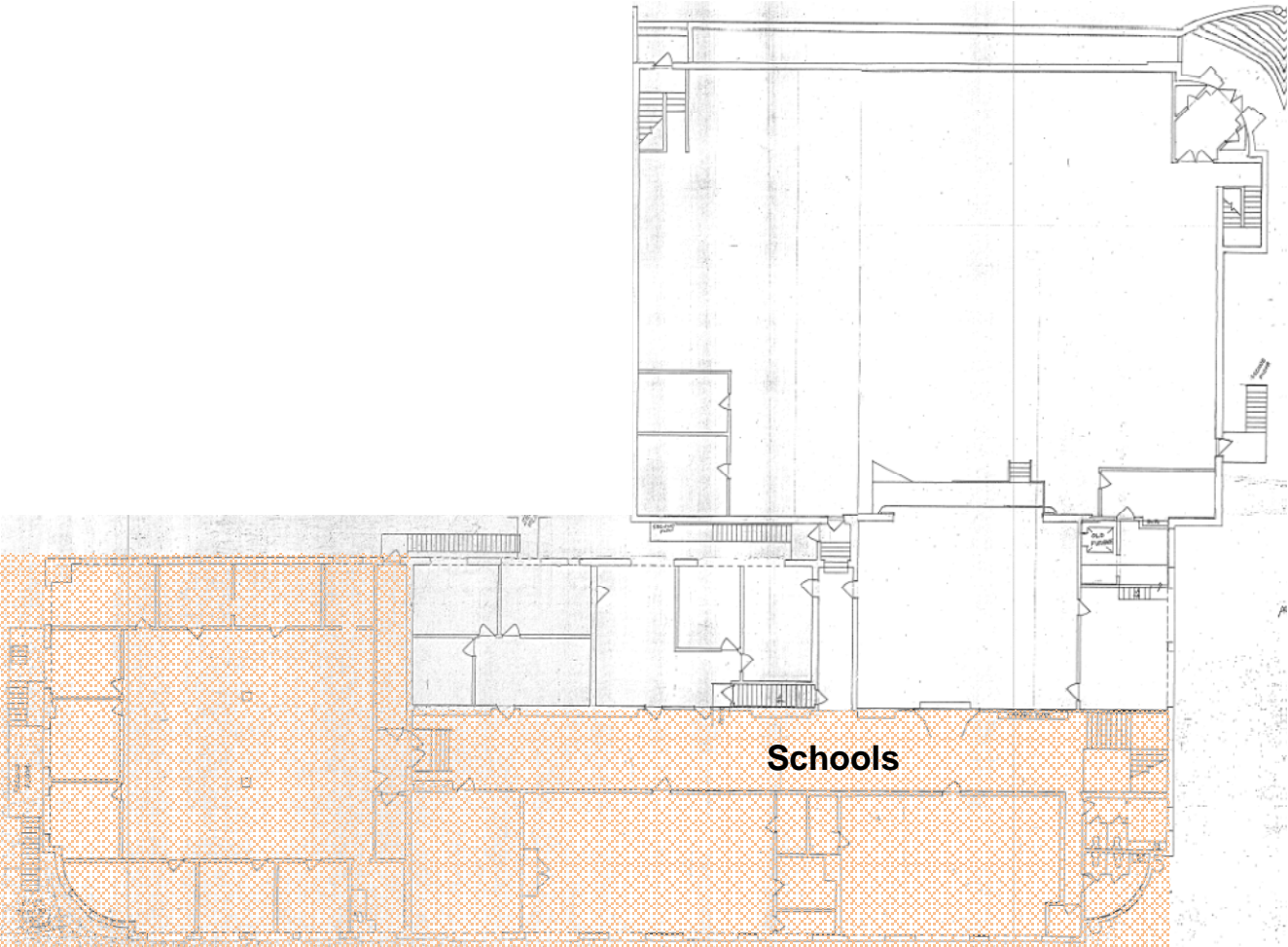

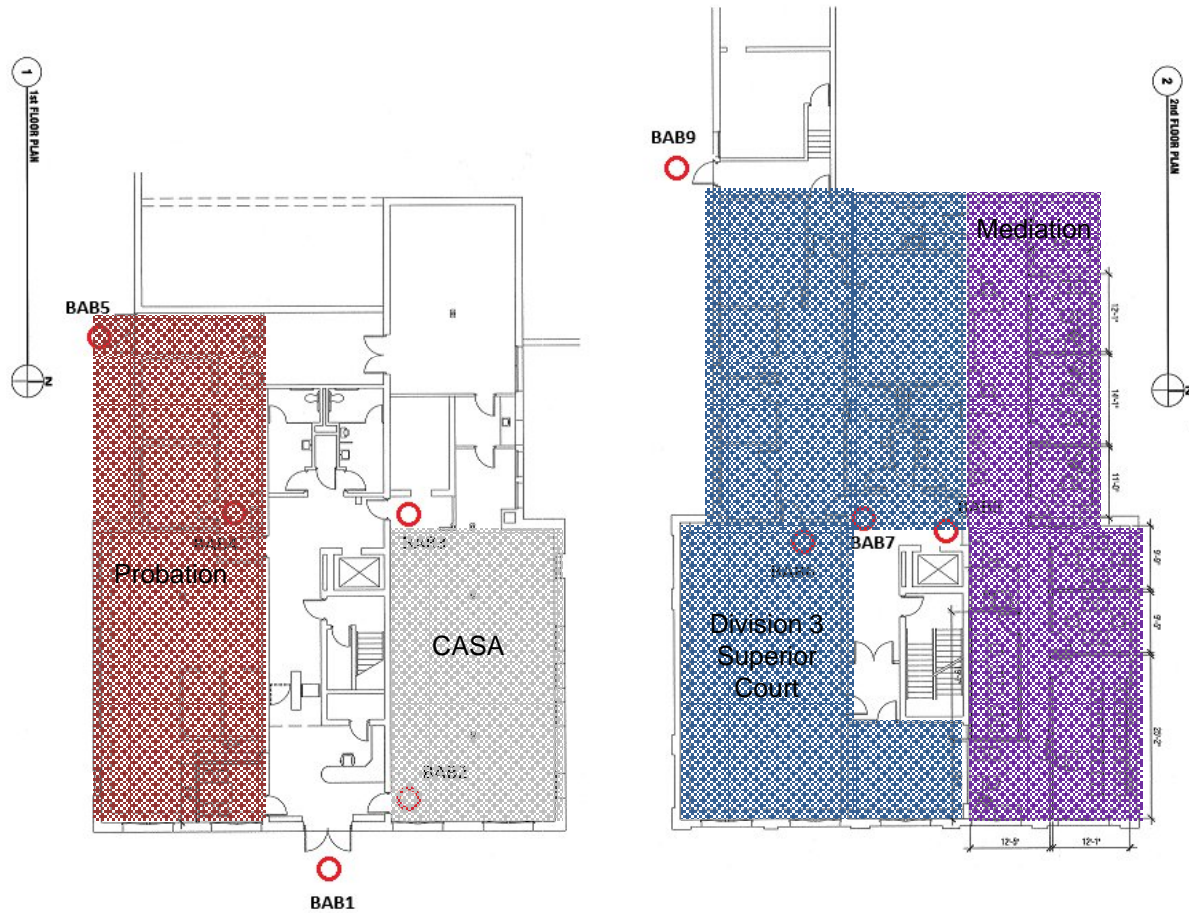

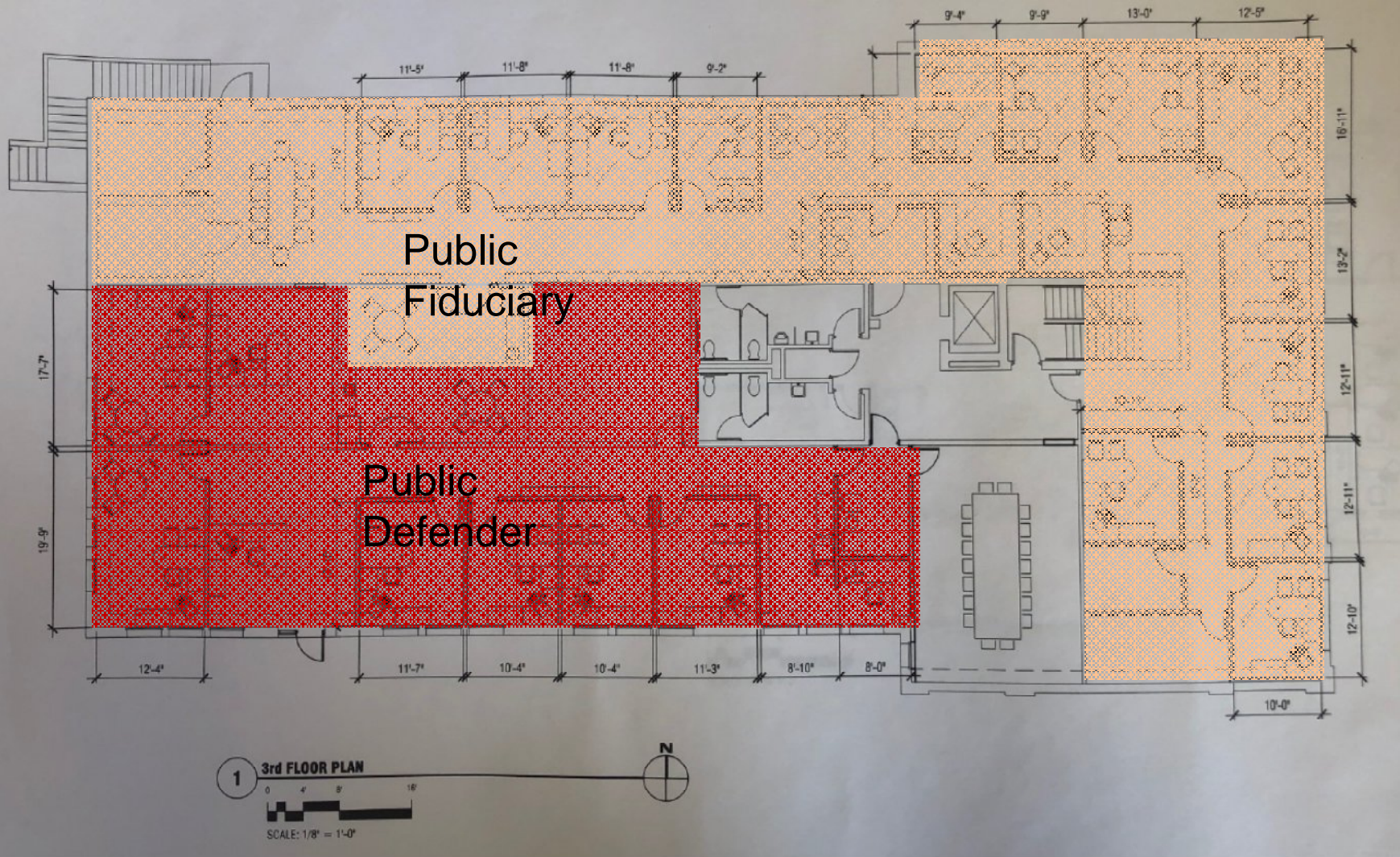

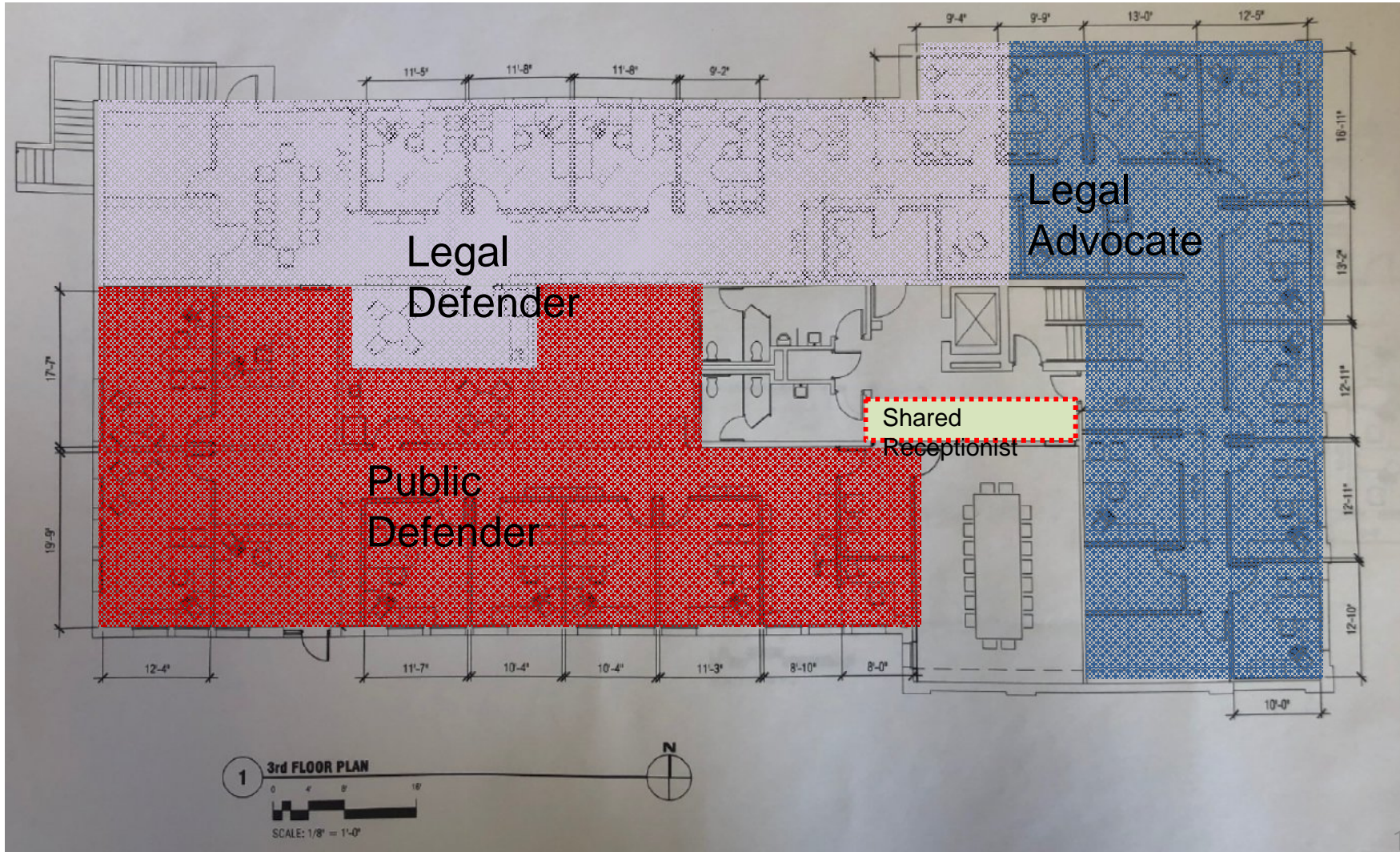

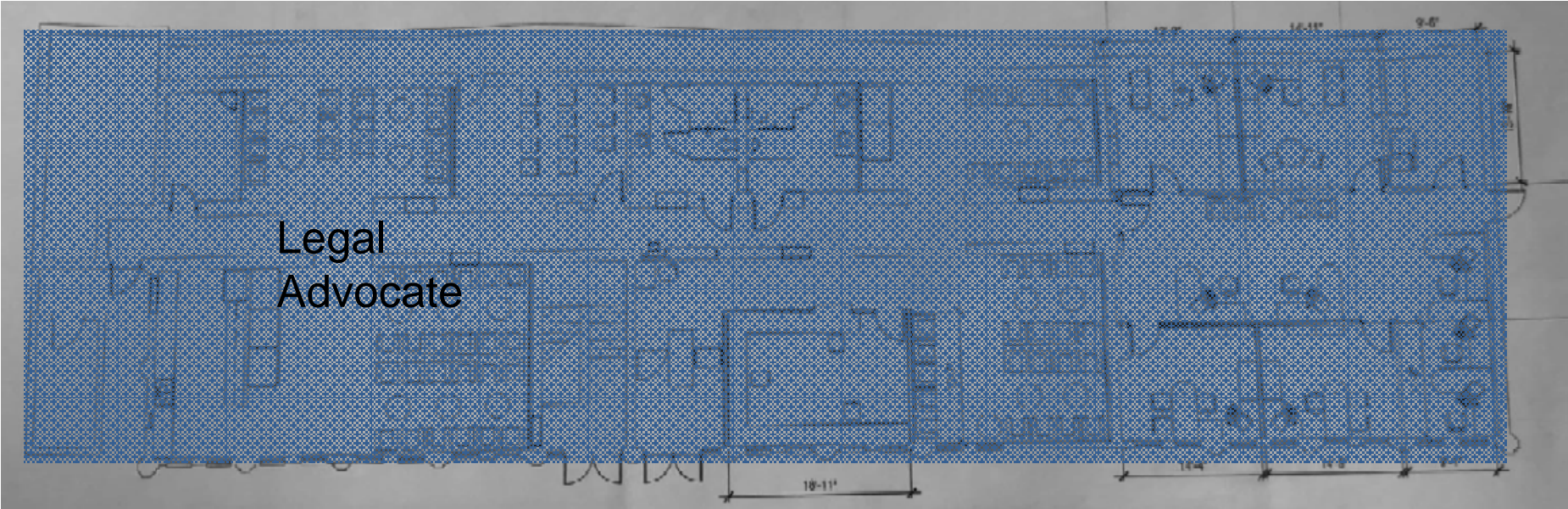

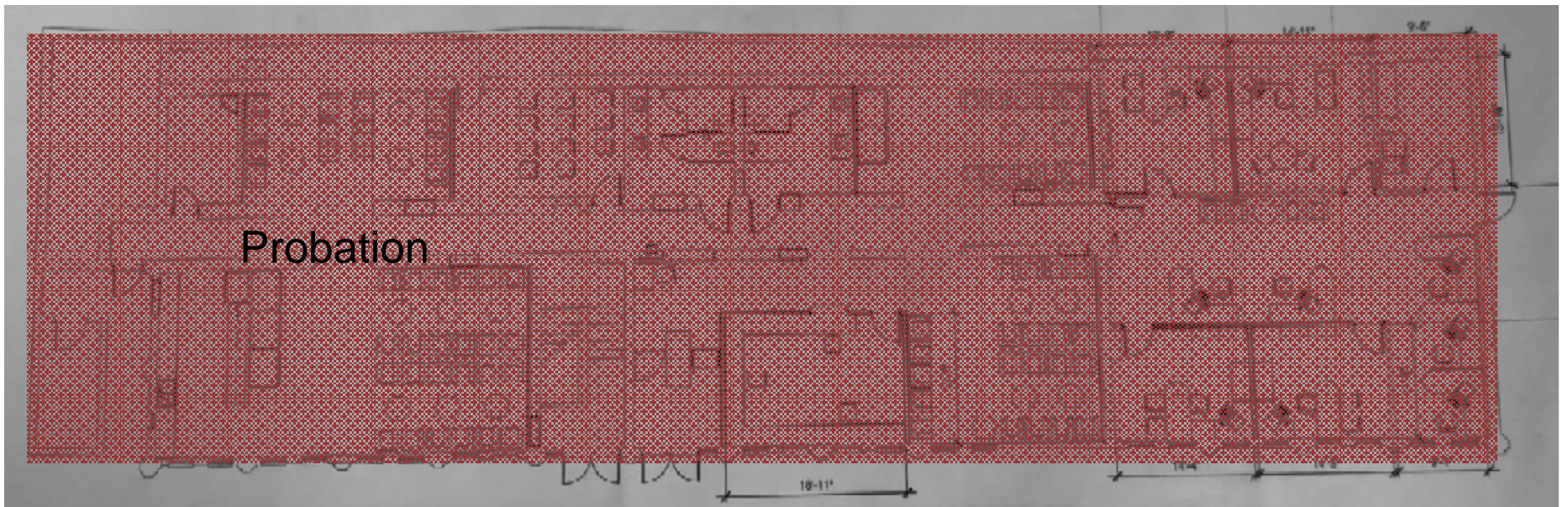

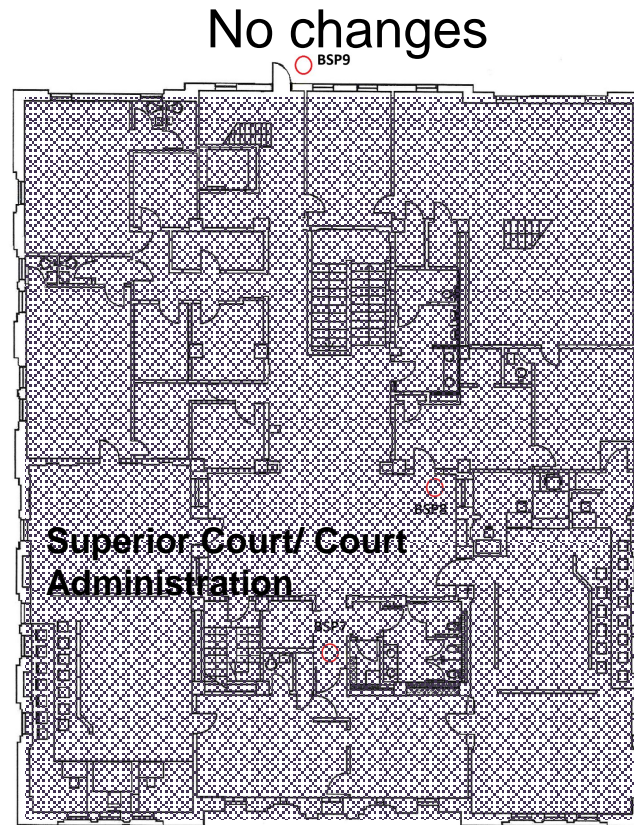

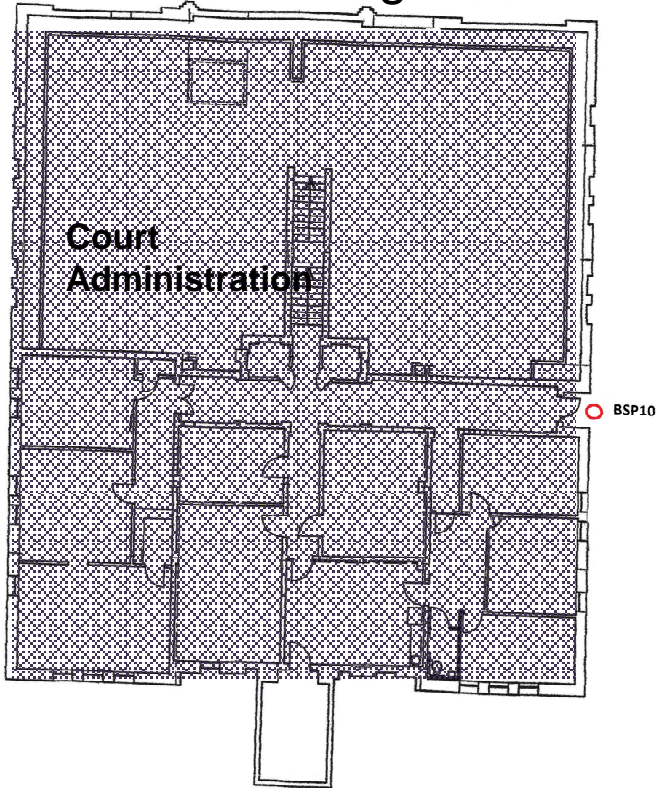

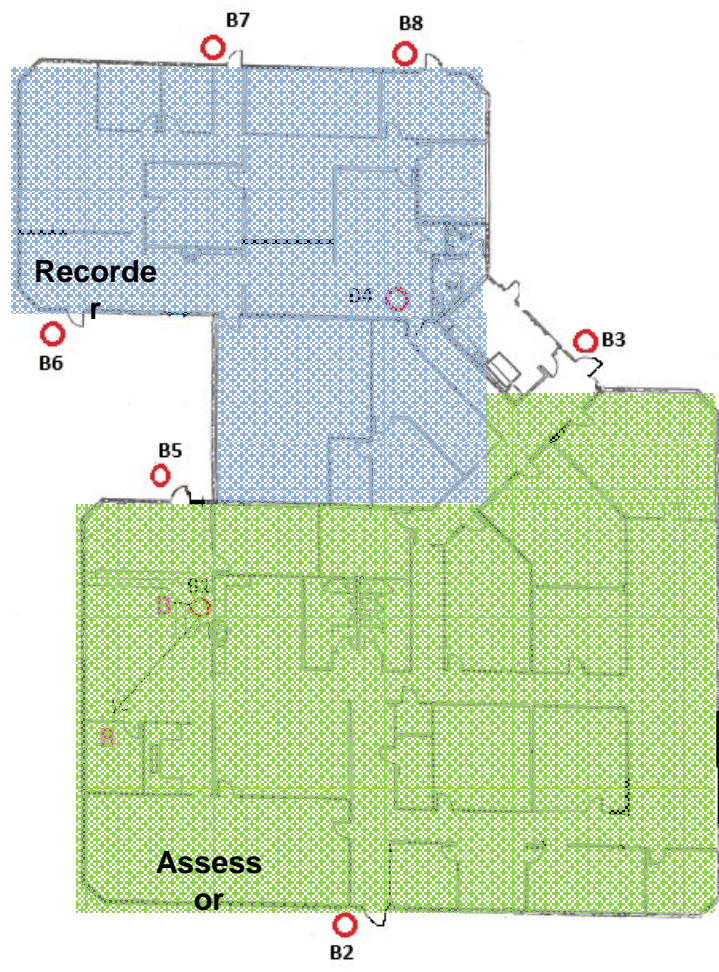
