

RESOLUTION 20-___

ALTERING THE ESTABLISHED WIDTH OF DAVIS ROAD, A DECLARED COUNTY HIGHWAY

WHEREAS, pursuant to ARS § 28-6701, there has been presented to the Board of Supervisors of Cochise County, Arizona, a recommendation by the County Engineer, praying for the altering of the established County Highway known as Davis Road to a width of 200 feet:

That portion of Davis Road beginning at the mid-section line of Sections 16 and 21, thence commencing in a easterly direction to the Section corner shared by Sections 13, 14, 23 and 24 All in Township 21 South Range 26 East of the Gila and Salt River Meridian, Cochise County, Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors on the 15th day of December, 2020, at the hour of 10:15 a.m., held a public hearing on said recommendation, and notice having been given by publication thereof once a week for two (2) weeks in the San Pedro Valley News-Sun, the designated official newspaper for Cochise County notices, and said notice having directed all persons wishing to object to the action prayed for in the petition to file with Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, a statement in writing setting forth any objections or opposition and to show cause why said petition should not be granted; and

WHEREAS, at said hearing the Board of Supervisors considered the feasibility, advantages and necessity of the highway and determined that the establishment of said road as requested in said petition is a public necessity, and that no landowner would be adversely affected thereby; and

WHEREAS, it having been determined that it is in the best interest of the County and the public at large to acquire said public rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the parcels to be affected by these rights-of-way acquisition are identified in Exhibit "A".

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that the establishment of the County Highway as above described is hereby approved.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is authorized and directed to file in the office of the County Recorder of Cochise County, Arizona, a certified copy of this resolution and order, together with a map of said highway.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Engineer, or her designee, is authorized to negotiate on behalf of the County to acquire said public rights-of-way, and settle resulting damages through donation, purchase or condemnation action as necessary.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that should condemnation action become necessary to acquire all, or any portion of, said rights-of-way, the Cochise County Attorney's Office is authorized to proceed with said action.

IT IS FINALLY RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, or the Vice-Chairman, is authorized to accept conveyance documents for said rights-of-way.

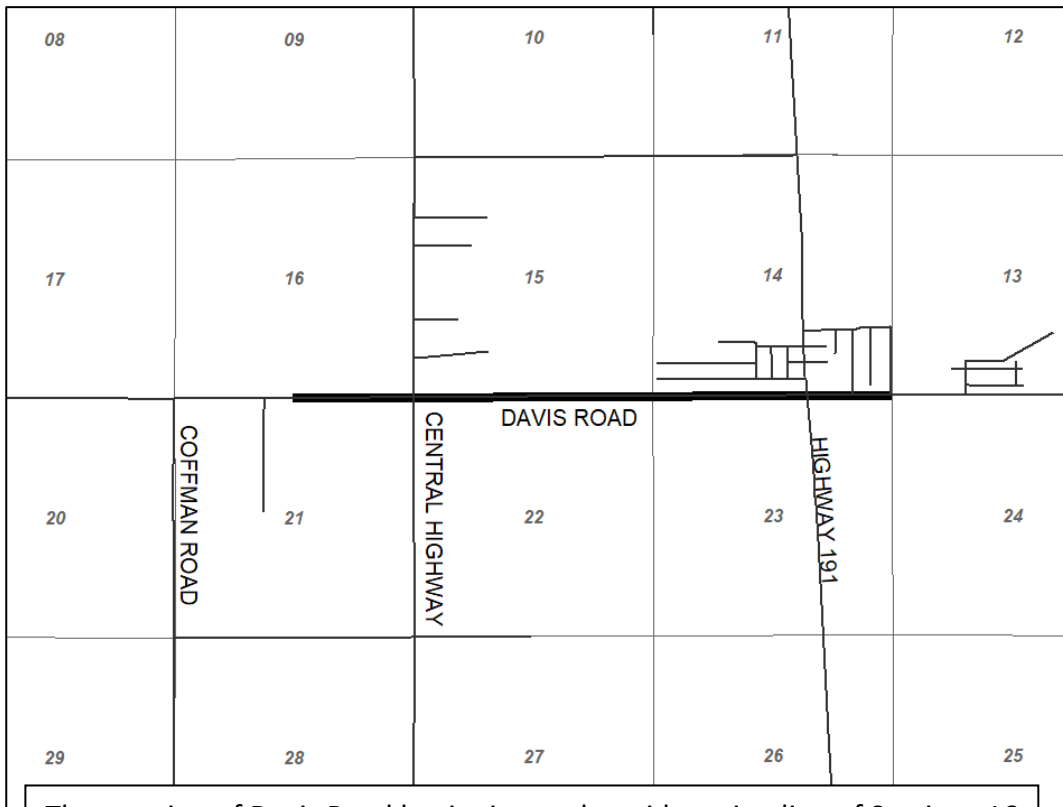
