

RESOLUTION 21-__

A RESOLUTION OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS APPROVING OF EFFORTS TO TRANSFER OWNERSHIP OF THE COCHISE COUNTY AIRPORT TO THE CITY OF WILLCOX.

WHEREAS, the Cochise County (“County”) is the owner and sponsor of the Cochise County Airport located in Willcox, Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the County is coordinating with the City of Willcox (“City”) and the Federal Aviation Administration (“FAA”) to consider the transfer of ownership of the Cochise County Airport to the City; and

WHEREAS, the County recognizes that the ownership and operation of the Cochise County Airport is important to the City’s local economy, as well as the County’s economy; and

WHEREAS, a City Council Work Session on September 3, 2020, the City expressed an interest in further exploring the liabilities, benefits, and opportunities of owning and controlling the Cochise County Airport; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to transfer the Cochise County Airport to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT S HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Cochise County Board of Supervisors approves of the County’s efforts to coordinate with the City of Willcox and the Federal Aviation Administration to transfer ownership and control of the Cochise County Airport to the City of Willcox.
