1. Briefly describe your organization's history, mission and goals.

The Sunsites-Pearce Fire District was formed in 1972 as a volunteer agency and has since grown to a full-time Fire and EMS agency that responds to 700+ calls per year with 8 full-time personnel. We endeavor to maintain excellence in Fire and EMS response by maintaining the highest standards in education and training, while providing the utmost degree of safety, security, and compassion to our members and community. Our goal is to continually expand to meet the needs of the community and neighboring Cochise County.

2. Sunsites-Pearce Fire District (SPFD), is a special tax district in Cochise County and receives funds from property taxes and other revenue through the Cochise County Treasurer's Office. SPFD has its own operations and planning budget which uses the funds described above. The Cochise County Board of Supervisors has agreed to allow special districts to utilize them as an accepting agency and pass through for grant funds including this project. We work with Ms. Kim Lemons, Cochise County Special Districts Coordinator, on projects that require our County's assistance for grant implementation.

3. Describe the proposed project and your plan to implement.

Our proposed project is to to replace our current wildland firefighting truck. Replacing this truck will fulfill two goals for our department. First, we will have a reliable truck that can meet the challenging needs as an emergency response vehicle. Second, it will increase our level of safety and ability to preform the job as wildland firefighters.



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Our current truck is a 2003 Dodge 3500 two-person cab. This truck has served our fire district for many years even though it is inadequate for our needs. Despite impeccable maintenance records, secondary to the demands of wildland firefighting the vehicle has broken down multiple times, often while on fire assignments. This has proven costly and extremely frustrating for the firefighting crews, not to mention dangerous.

Our plan is to purchase a new four-person cab and chassis truck that has a large weight capacity, and outfit it with new storage boxes, lightbar, siren, striping and pump. Once in service, the truck will be available to respond to local as well as national requests. SPFD will maintain the truck and equipment with the same high level of excellency as all the fleet.

4. Describe how the proposed project satisfies one or more of the priority funding areas identified by the Gila River Indian Community.

This proposal satisfies the public safety funding priority of the Gila River Indian Community.

5. Identify the needs/problems to be addressed, target population and number of people to be served by the project.

Our need is to have a reliable fire brush truck to respond to brush fires. Particulary, due to the extreme drought the Southwest is currently facing, the wildland/brush fire threat has expanded from a few months in the summer, to a year round challenge. The problem is that our current brush truck is 18 years old with a growing history of maintainace and safety problems, and often is not in-service when it is needed.

The target population is the community of Sunsites-Pearce, Arizona, approximately 7000 people. However, because of the unique nature of the fire service, this truck will be placed on a list for national availability, and could be assigned anywhere in the United States for short periods of time.

6. Define the project as a new or continuing program. Has GRIC previously funded this project?

This will be a new project so that we are able to continue the level of firefighting service that we provide. Without this grant award, we will not be able to continue to provide the service to our community let alone other communities throughout the Unites States. The GRIC has not funded this project prior.

7. Provide a brief timeline including start and finish dates. Indicate if the timeline is flexible.



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Upon being awarded funds we expect the funds would be deposited into our M&O account via the Cochise County Treasury office within 4 months. This long of a delay is due to past experiences with grant aid pass through agreements between our fire district and the county, but could be sooner. After funds are deposited into our account and accepted by our district board the vehicle and boxes would be purchased within 2 months. Equipment will then be received within two months of purchase. After the equipment is received the boxes tank and pump will be installed on the truck taking up to two weeks. A date will then be set to have striping done which would take up to two weeks. From grant award to brush truck in service would be no more than 9 months.

8. Identify other organizations, partners or funders participating in the project and their roles.

There are no other organizations involved in this project. Although we support multiple other agencies, including the Arizona Department of Forestry and Fire management with firefighting efforts, they are not included on this grant.

9. Would you be able to implement the proposed plan if your organization received partial funding for this project?

Yes. If the Gila River funded only the cost of the truck and striping we could use the boxes, pump, and lightbar/ siren and remove them off the old truck and mount them on the new truck. The boxes have been in service for many years and although they have sustained damage over years of use they could be reused. This is the same case for the pump and lightbar/ siren. Thus if partially funded the minimum funding needed from GRIC would be \$67,772.50.

10. Describe your plan for project financial sustainability beyond the grant period. If this is a program/project previously funded by the Gila River Indian Community describe efforts made towards the previously described sustainability plan.

Our department already has a dedicated maintenance budget to account for various forms of work that will be needed. The hope is that this could reduce our budget size as a new vehicle is less likely to have mechanical problems. We hope that in the future the fire district will become more self sustainable so that grants are not needed to replace emergency apparatus, but at this time help is needed for large capital expense. The new vehicle will help with our sustainability plan because it will be able to lower our maintenance costs, and it will be able to generate revenue when it is assigned to out of district fires.



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11. Describe your plan to document progress and results.

During the stepwise process, each invoice or check received is date stamped. The truck will have to be ordered and received, and then made into a wildland firefighting apparatus, which involves work that will be done by our own firefighters, (lots of planning, some welding and fitting of equipment to the truck). The vehicle will be placed in service when it is ready, and results would be in the continued ability to respond to wildland fires both local and nationally.

1. Dodge 5500 Chassis. This is the bulk of the grant and will be the replacement truck. It meets the weight requirements needed for a firefighting brush truck. This dollar amount was acquired by receiving a direct quote from Courtesy Chrysler in Mesa, AZ.

2. Whelen Light bar and siren. This light bar and siren is a requirement for emergency response vehicles. If partial funding is awarded the old lightbar will be reused. Dollar amount was derived from a direct quote from B&B selectcom in Tucson AZ.

3. Equipment boxes. These boxes will replace the current boxes that are on our brush truck that have been used for the entire life of the vehicle. If only partial funding is provided the old boxes will be reused. Box prices based off quote from CreedBilt in Gilbert AZ.

4. Striping- As a fire apparatus this vehicle will need to be striped and lettered as such. Quote from CMI signs in Safford AZ who has done prior stripping for department vehicles.

5. Firefighting Pump- Firefighting Pumps are required for firefighting brush trucks without them there is no way to get water onto a fire. The current pump on our brush truck is out of date and no longer being manufactured. The fear is it will one day break and parts to fix it will be unavailable. If partial funding is awarded we would reuse the old fire pump. Price derived from quote from Industrial Source National Firefighting Corp.
