

**RESOLUTION 21-20**

**AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF ROADS TO THE COCHISE COUNTY ROAD  
MAINTENANCE SYSTEM**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors (“Board”) is authorized to lay out, maintain, control, and manage public roads under its jurisdiction, pursuant to A.R.S. § 11-251(4); and

**WHEREAS**, on November 13, 1989, the Board approved the official Cochise County Maintained Road System Maps, by Resolution 89-107, which has been amended from time to time; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board may spend public monies for maintenance of public roads and streets other than legally designated state and county highways, pursuant to A.R.S. § 28-6705(A1); and

**WHEREAS**, the following segments, as depicted in **Exhibit “A”**, attached hereto, have subsequently been laid out, opened, and constructed in accordance with standard engineering and road specifications adopted by the Board of Supervisors without cost to the County and have been inspected by the County Engineer; and

**NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, that we, the Board of Supervisors of Cochise County, do hereby approve the following revision to be made to the Cochise County Maintained Road System Maps:

| <b>Dark Star Road</b> | Maintenance I.D. #1607- Add Dark Star Road, approximately 270.40 feet from the westerly right-of-way of State Highway 90, westerly 1.1 miles |
| <b>Vidal Trail</b>    | Maintenance I.D. #1608- Add Vidal Trail, from the intersection of Dark Star Road and Vidal Trail, southerly 0.27 miles                       |

**Calvary Lane** Maintenance I.D. #1609- Add Calvary Lane, from the intersection of Vidal Trail and Calvary Lane, easterly 0.14 miles

**IT IS FINALLY RESOLVED** that we, the Board of Supervisors, do hereby approve the addition of 1.51 miles of maintenance on the roads described above.

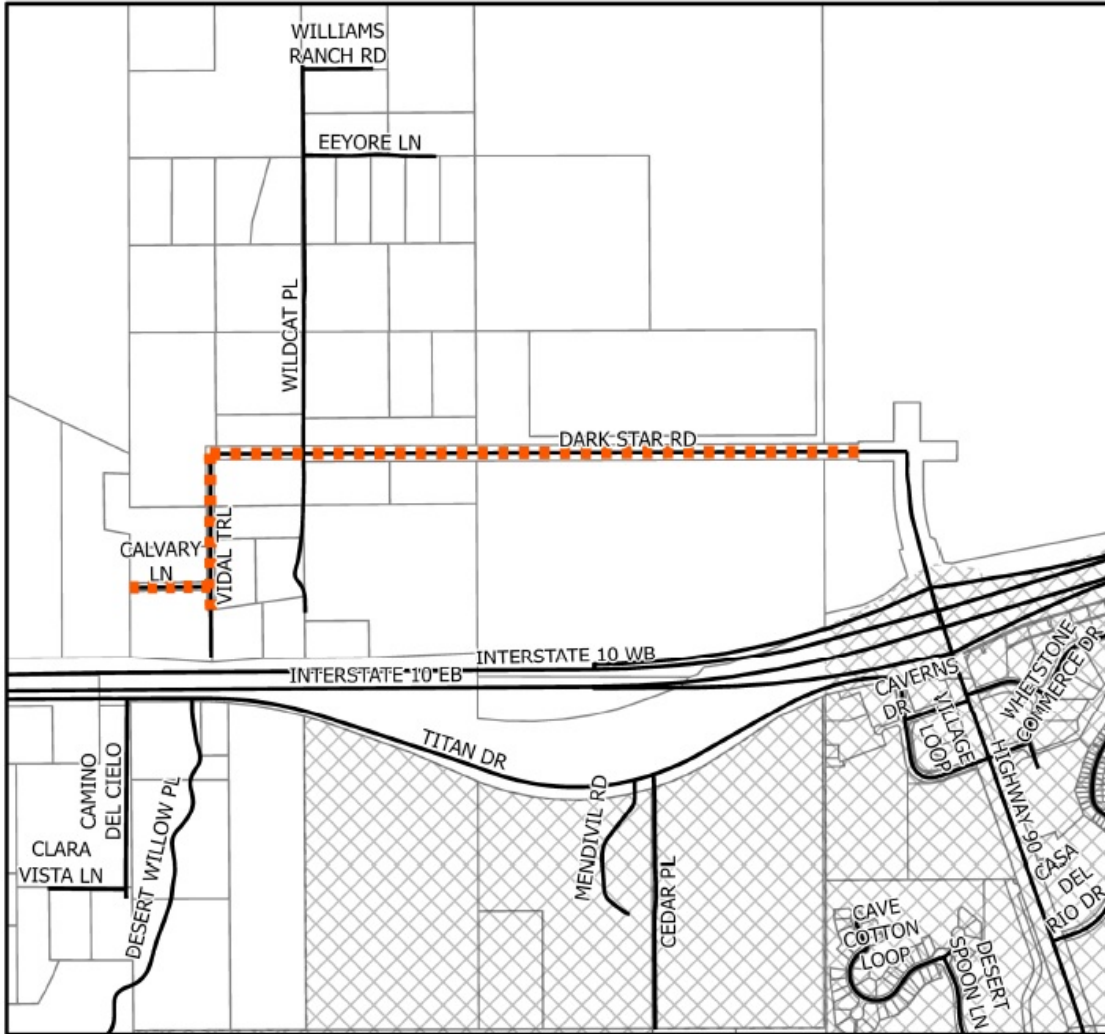
