

PUBLIC HEARING

ALTERATION OF THE WIDTH OF A DECLARED COUNTY HIGHWAY

There has been filed with the Board of Supervisors of Cochise County, Arizona, a recommendation by the County Engineer, to alter the width of a declared County Highway, more particularly described as follows:

That portion of Moson Road commencing at the intersection of Moson Road and Hereford Road, thence to north the intersection of Moson Road and State Route 90, at a width of 100 feet, traversing Sections 2, 3, 10 and 11, Township 23 South Range 21 East and Sections 2,3, 10, 11, 14, 15, 22, 23, 26, 27, 34 and 35 in Township 22 South Range 21 East of the Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, Cochise County, Arizona.

Notice is hereby given that Tuesday, November 16th, 2021 at the hour of 10:00 a.m., at the Office of the Board of Supervisors in Building G, 1415 W. Melody Lane, Bisbee, Arizona, is hereby set as the time and place for Hearing on said Petition and all objections thereto, and all persons wishing to object to the action prayed for in the petition are directed to file with the Board, a statement in writing setting forth any objections, or opposition and to show cause why said petition should not be granted; and

That notice of said hearing be published in the Sierra Vista Herald once (1) a week for two (2) consecutive weeks prior to the date of said hearing.
