

RESOLUTION 21-21

**AUTHORIZING THE ALTERATION OF THE WIDTH OF THE
DECLARED COUNTY HIGHWAY MOSON ROAD IN HEREFORD**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Cochise County, Arizona is authorized to alter or abandon a County Highway pursuant to ARS § 28-6701 through 28-6703; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ARS § 28-6701, there has been presented to the Board of Supervisors of Cochise County, Arizona, a recommendation by the County Engineer, praying for the alteration of the Established County Highway known as Moson Road:

That portion of Moson Road commencing at the intersection of Moson Road and Hereford Road, thence to north the intersection of Moson Road and State Route 90, at a width of 100 feet, traversing Sections 2, 3, 10 and 11, Township 23 South Range 21 East and Sections 2,3, 10, 11, 14, 15, 22, 23, 26, 27, 34 and 35 in Township 22 South Range 21 East of the Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, Cochise County, Arizona; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors on the 16th of November, 2021, at the hour of 10:00 a.m., held a public hearing on said recommendation, and notice having been given by publication thereof once a week for two (2) weeks in the Sierra Vista Herald, the designated official newspaper for Cochise County notices, and said notice having directed all persons wishing to object to the action prayed for in the petition to file with Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, a statement in writing setting forth any objections or opposition and to show cause why said petition should not be granted; and,

WHEREAS, at said hearing the Board of Supervisors considered the feasibility, advantages and necessity of the highway and determined that the alteration of said road as requested is a public necessity, and that no landowner would be adversely affected thereby; and,

WHEREAS, it having been determined that it is in the best interest of the County and the public at large to acquire said public rights-of-way; and,

WHEREAS, the parcels to be affected by these rights-of-way acquisition are identified in **Exhibit "A"**.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that the alteration of the County Highway as above described is hereby approved.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is authorized and directed to file in the office of the County Recorder of Cochise County, Arizona, a certified copy of this resolution and order, together with a map of said highway.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Engineer, or her designee, is authorized to negotiate on behalf of the County to acquire said public rights-of-way, and settle resulting damages through donation, purchase, or condemnation action as necessary.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that should condemnation action become necessary to acquire all, or any portion of, said rights-of way, the Cochise County Attorney's Office is authorized to proceed with said action.

IT IS FINALLY RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, or the Vice-Chairman, is authorized to accept conveyance documents for said rights-of-way.

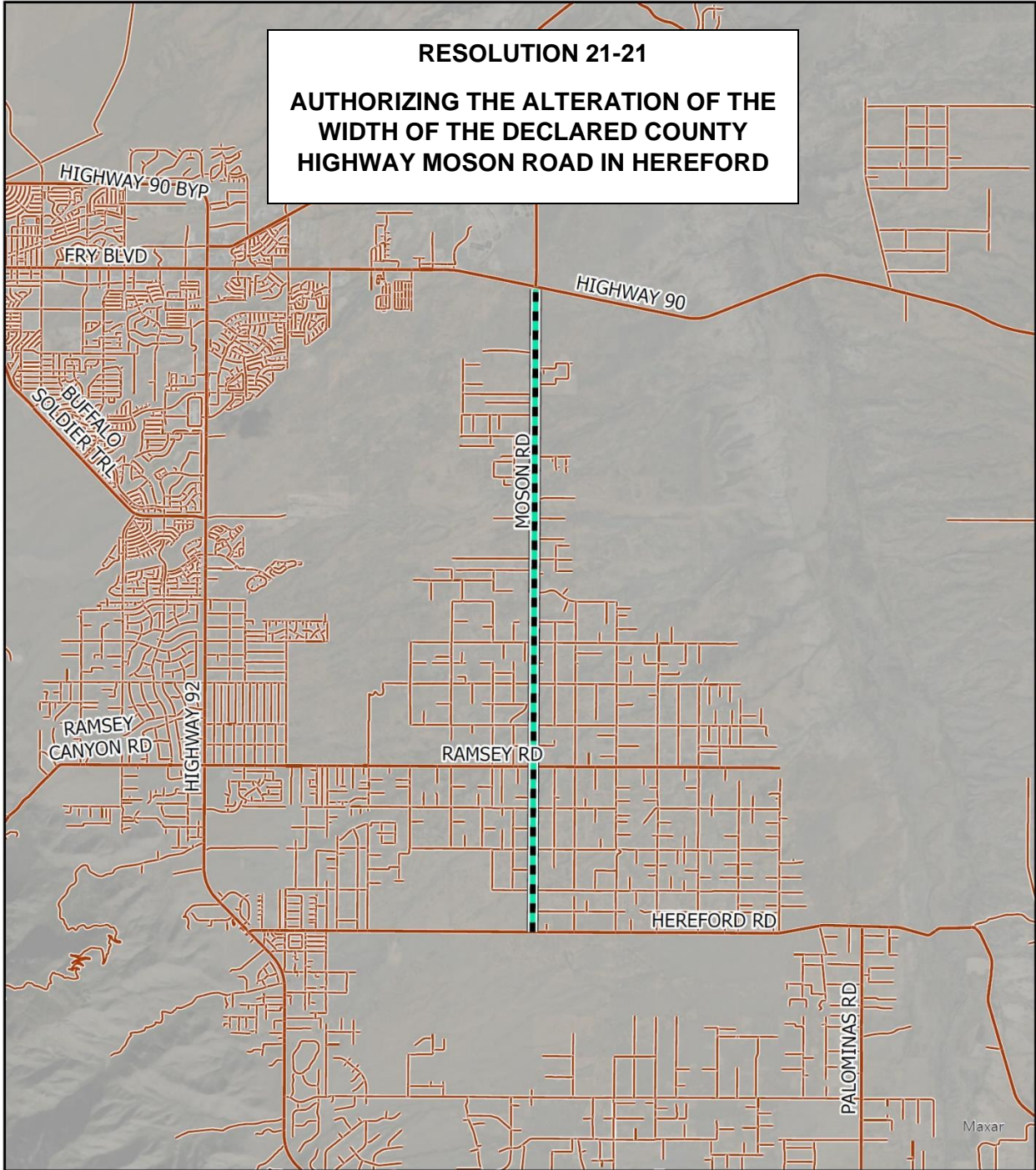
