- Utilized 99.7%

## Statewide

- Received 2,819,270
- Administered 3,041,773
- Utilized 107.9%

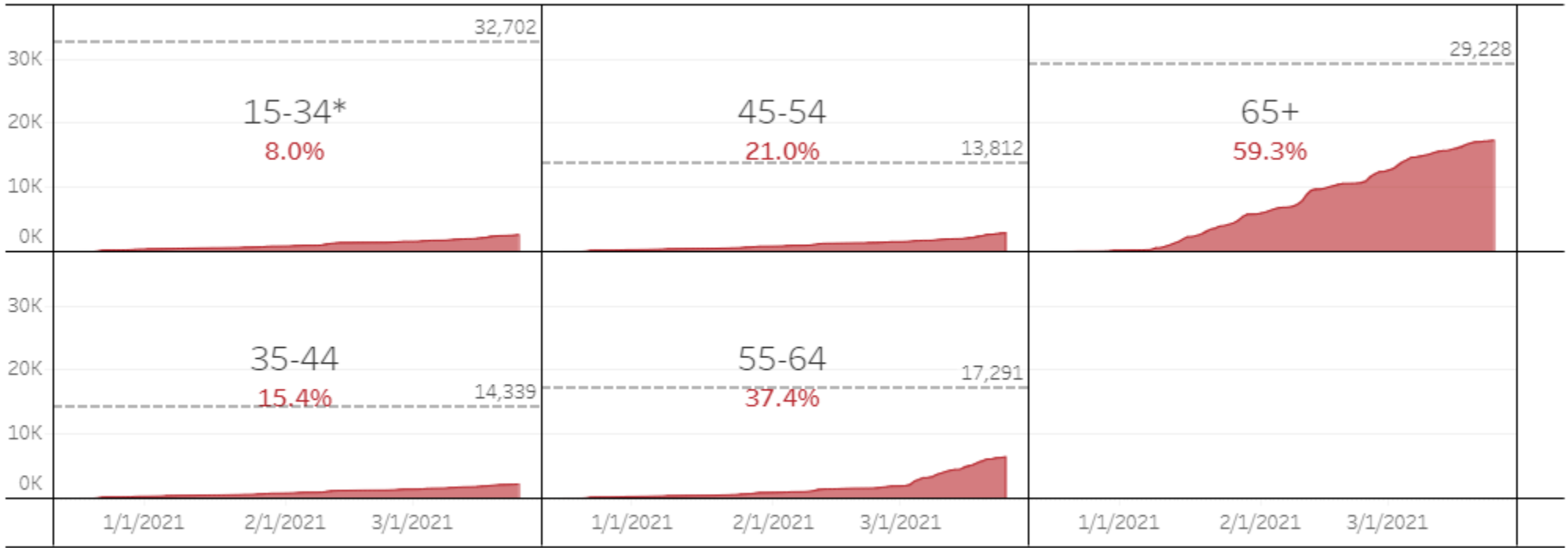
# Vaccine Ages 3/25/21 | Updates

## VMS and Phases

- Very important that we **do not** administer Moderna or Janssen to anyone under 18. The EUA does not authorize the use for either of these vaccines for anyone under 18. Pfizer was authorized for 16+
  - VMS now includes an icon for minors
  - **If you administer to anyone under 18 it must be reported into VAERS**

## Frontline Essential Workers\*\*

Janssen (Johnson & Johnson) MARCH 2021 – SUMMER 2021

- Food and agriculture
- Grocery store, convenience store, and pharmacies
- U.S. Postal Service
- Manufacturing workers
- Public transit workers, including bus, light rail, Uber, Lyft, taxis, and rideshare
- Utility Workers
- State and local government workers
- Funeral home workers
- Others as determined by ACIP guidelines

## Phase 1B Prioritized 1B

Vaccinations will continue for groups previously listed under Phase 1A and Prioritized Phase 1B:

- Healthcare workers & healthcare support occupations
- Emergency medical services workers
- Long-term care facility staff & residents
- Education & childcare workers
- Protective services occupations
- Adults 65 and older

\* Transitions to other age groups are based on  $\geq 55\%$  of current age group covered OR decreased demand in current group

\*\* Defined by ACIP as subset of essential workers at highest risk for work-related exposure due to required work-related duties performed onsite and being in close proximity (<6 feet) to public or coworkers. List may vary by local jurisdiction.

Distribution groups and timelines of phases shown are tentative. This information is subject to change due to future vaccine distribution guidance recommendations, FDA approval of vaccines, and vaccine allocation/availability.

# Vaccine Strategies 3/25/21 | Updates

## Strategy for Hard-to-Reach Populations

- Focusing on smaller communities and migrant workers
  - Fry in Willcox (Janssen)
  - Copper Queen in Tombstone
  - NCCH in Bowie and San Simon
  - CCHCI out at farms (Janssen)
  - Fry/SVFM in Huachuca City (Janssen)
  - In talks with U of A Mobile Outreach Clinic and Task Force Med
- Homebound individuals
  - CHSS is planning on mobilizing teams
