### Agenda Number: HLT 6237 – Date of BOS Meeting 1/25/2022

#### **Recommendation:**

Approve ADHS #18-180472, Amendment #4, Arizona Prescription Drug Overdose Prevention Program, between the Arizona Department of Health Services and Cochise Health & Social Services in the amount of \$470,720 for the period of 9/1/2021 – 9/29/2022.

#### **Background (Brief):**

The original Overdose Prevention Contract with ADHS was approved November 2017. This grant amendment funding will continue to support expanded prevention-based strategies, enhance linkages to care, the peer navigation contract, the overdose fatality review tasks, public health social work resources to county inmates; and support data collection, analysis and reporting for localized trends in opioid use disorders aligned with public health best practices. The deliverables Cochise County provides to ADHS and the total annual IGA amount remain the same as amendment 3.

#### **Fiscal Impact & Funding Sources:**

This is a grant-funded fixed-price program through the Arizona Department of Health Services in the amount of \$470,720. Funds are a combination of federal and state funding.
