**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE
COUNTY OF COCHISE, ARIZONA, AGREEING TO COOPERATE WITH THE CITY OF
DOUGLAS, ARIZONA FOR VOLUNTARY TRANSFER OF HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHERS
AND FAMILY SELF-SUFFICIENCY PROGRAM TO THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF COCHISE
COUNTY**

WHEREAS, the City of Douglas, Arizona, AZ037, (“City”) currently administers 193 allocated Housing Choice Voucher Section 8 Program (“HCVP”) and Family Self-Sufficiency (“FSS”) for the benefit of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Housing Authority of Cochise County, AZ034, (“HACC”) is to expand affordable housing options, promote homeownership, and improve the quality of housing in Cochise County, and the HACC also currently administers HCVP and FSS with a high Section 8 Management Assessment Program performance designation, and the HACC is committed to serving the population of the City’s jurisdiction with administrative performance equal to the HACC’s current high rating by affirmatively furthering fair housing and by reducing racial and national origin concentrations; and

WHEREAS, the parties have determined that it is in the best interest of the City and the HACC that the City voluntarily transfers the HCVP and FSS of the City to HACC effective January 1, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the City will voluntarily transfer the HCVP and FSS of the City to HACC according to terms set forth in an intergovernmental agreement between HACC and the City, and in compliance with terms provided in Notice PIH 2018-12.
