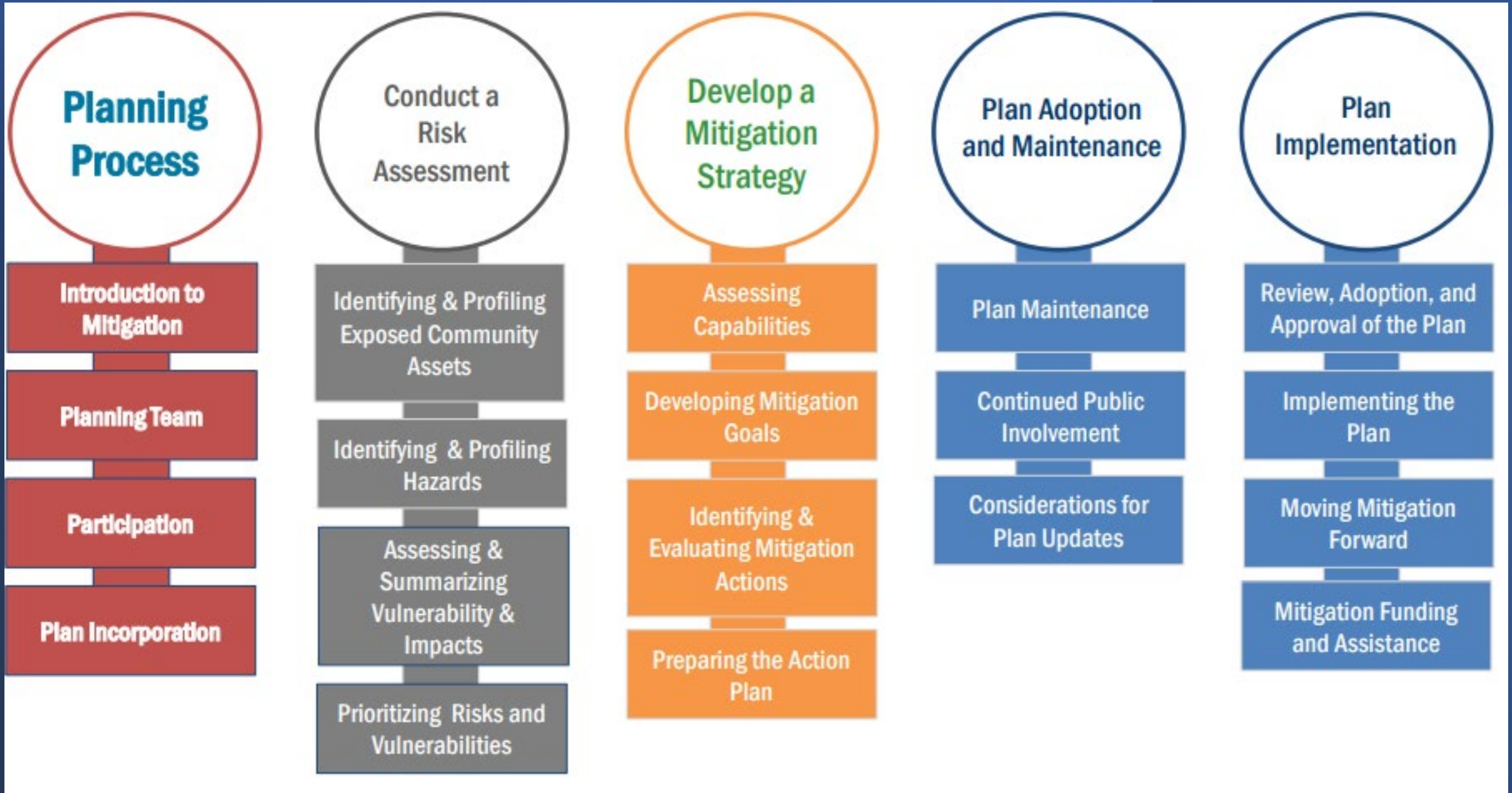

## Flood Mitigation Assistance (FMA)

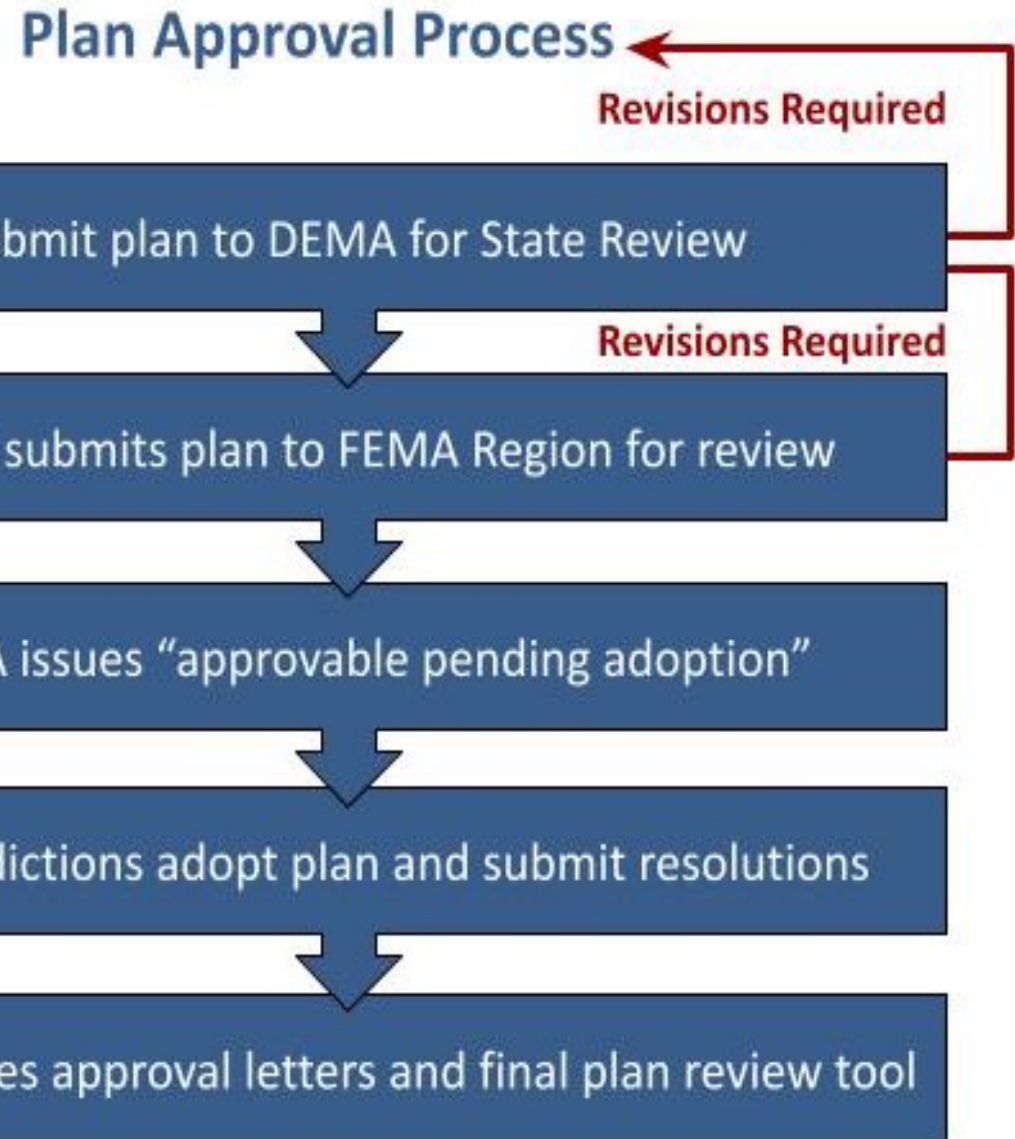
- Available Annually
- Flood Only

## Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC)

- Replaces Pre-Disaster Mitigation (PDM)
- Available Annually
- All Hazards

# Plan Approval Process

- Submitted to FEMA December 30, 2022
- Upon “approval pending adoption” from FEMA, all jurisdictions can adopt the plan and submit resolutions to us to add to the plan
- Final approval comes from FEMA
