

Pool

The City Pool was built in 1950 and paid for through the Arizona State Parks Grant. The operating budget for the pool is \$160,000 each year and includes chemicals, water, heating, and staffing. The City also has one of the only remaining vinyl siding commercial pools in Arizona. To replace the vinyl siding which is 10 years overdue is estimated to cost \$90,000-\$150,000. The operating system is beyond its life and will cost \$200,000 to replace. In 2020, the pool heater caught on fire and no longer functions. Consultants have recommended a full rebuild of the City Pool. The new design will be more cost effective for the City of Willcox and easier to maintain while still offering a valuable amenity to the community. Cost: \$500,000 - \$700,000
