

RESOLUTION 23-_____

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SALE OF THE SMALL MODULAR 1990/1991 TRAILER
AT TOVREAVILLE ROAD BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
COCHISE COUNTY, ARIZONA**

WHEREAS, A.R.S. § 11-251(9) authorizes Cochise County to dispose of surplus equipment and materials that have little or no value, or that are unauctionable in any manner authorized by the board; and

WHEREAS, the County owns an aged small modular 1990/1991 trailer located at Tovreaville Road formerly used for jail visitation that is of little value and is suitable for demolition and that needs to be removed from its current location in order for the County to make use of the underlying parcel; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bisbee is willing to purchase and move the trailer; and

WHEREAS, the Cochise County Board of Supervisors has unanimously approved this disposition of the trailer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the small modular 1990/1991 trailer located at Tovreaville Road will be sold without auction to City of Bisbee for the sum of \$1.00, according to terms of the Bill of Sale and without warranty whatsoever.
