**AUTHORIZATION TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS
AND IMPLEMENT CDBG PROJECTS**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY SUPERVISORS OF COCHISE COUNTY AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION(S) FOR FY2023 STATE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS, CERTIFYING THAT SAID APPLICATION(S) MEETS THE COMMUNITY'S PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT NEEDS AND THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE CDBG PROGRAM, AND AUTHORIZING ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT AND COMPLETE THE ACTIVITIES OUTLINED IN SAID APPLICATION.

WHEREAS, Cochise County is desirous of undertaking community development activities; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona is administering the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program; and

WHEREAS, the State CDBG Program requires that CDBG funds requested address one of the three Congressionally mandated National Objectives; and

WHEREAS, the activities within this application(s) address the community's identified housing and community development needs, including the needs of low and moderate-income persons; and

WHEREAS, an Applicant of State CDBG funds is required to comply with the program guidelines and Federal Statutes and regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Supervisors of Cochise County, Arizona authorize application to be made to the State of Arizona, Department of Housing for FY2023 CDGB funds, and authorize the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to sign application(s) and contracts or grant documents for receipt and use of these funds for Owner Occupied Housing Rehabilitation, and authorize the Chair of the Board of

Supervisors to take all action necessary to implement and complete the activities submitted in said application(s); and

THAT this application for State CDBG funds meet the requirements of low-and moderate-income benefit for activities justified as benefitting low-and-moderate income persons, aids in the prevention or elimination of slum or blight or addresses an urgent need which poses a threat to health; and

THAT Cochise County will comply with all State CDBG Program guidelines, Federal Statutes, and regulations applicable to the State CDBG Program and the certifications contained in this application(s).
