COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANTS (CDBG)



Federal Grant Program

Rural Program administered by Arizona
Department of Housing

CDBG NATIONAL OBJECTIVES (GRANT CRITERIA)

Project must primarily benefit low and moderate income persons

Project must prevent or eliminate slum or blight conditions

Project must meet urgent needs related to health and safety issues

CDBG NATIONAL OBJECTIVES (GRANT CRITERIA)

01 Project must Primarily Benefit Low and Moderate Income Persons

51% of beneficiaries are Low and Moderate income
(Income is 80% or less of average income for same size family in the area.)

Certain categories of persons are considered low-income by definition
(seniors, disabled, domestic violence victims)

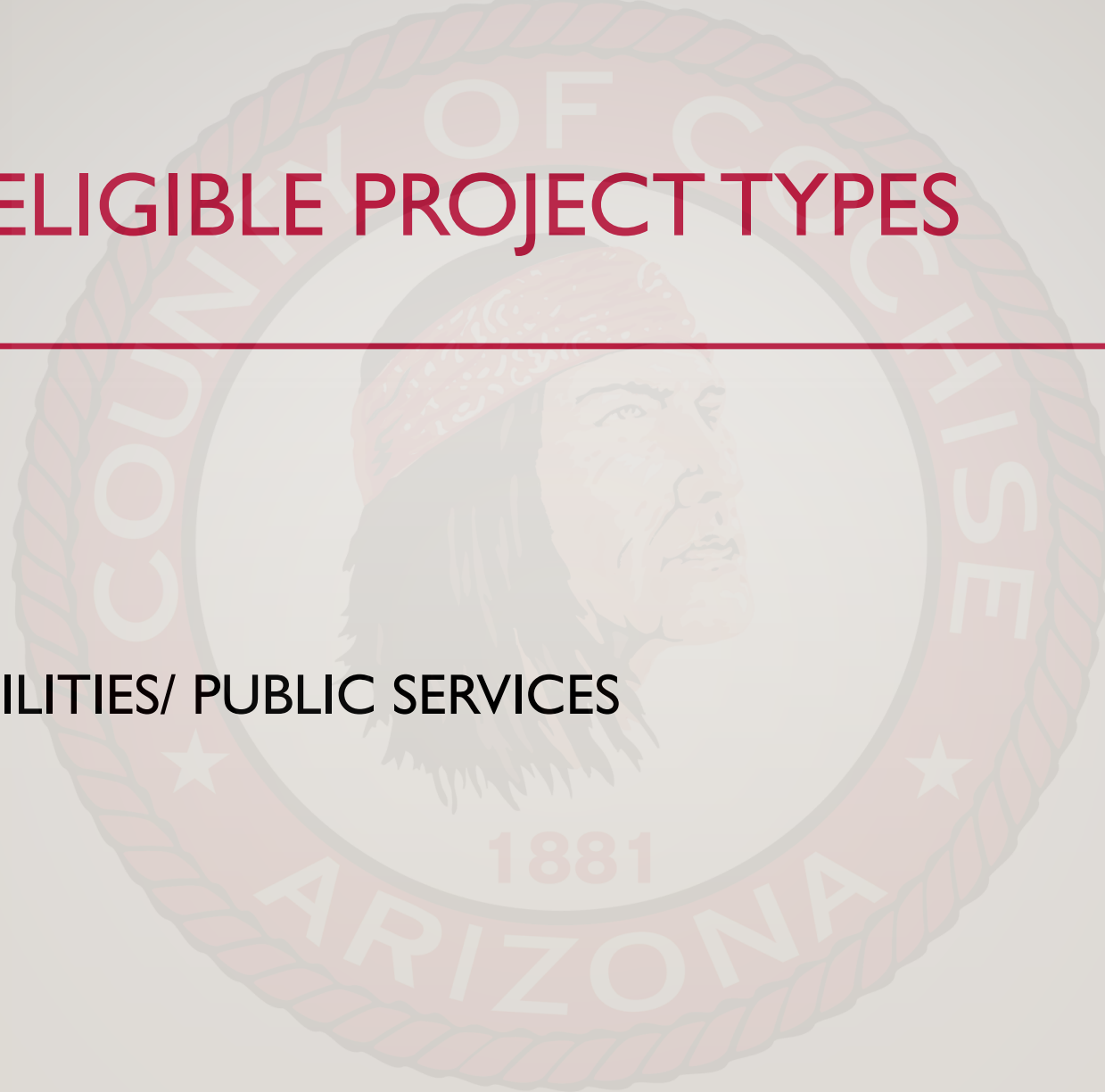

(e.g. Habitat for Humanity)

Activities that Support New Housing Construction
(e.g. land acquisition, clearance, and street improvements)

Homeownership Assistance (e.g. down-payment assistance)

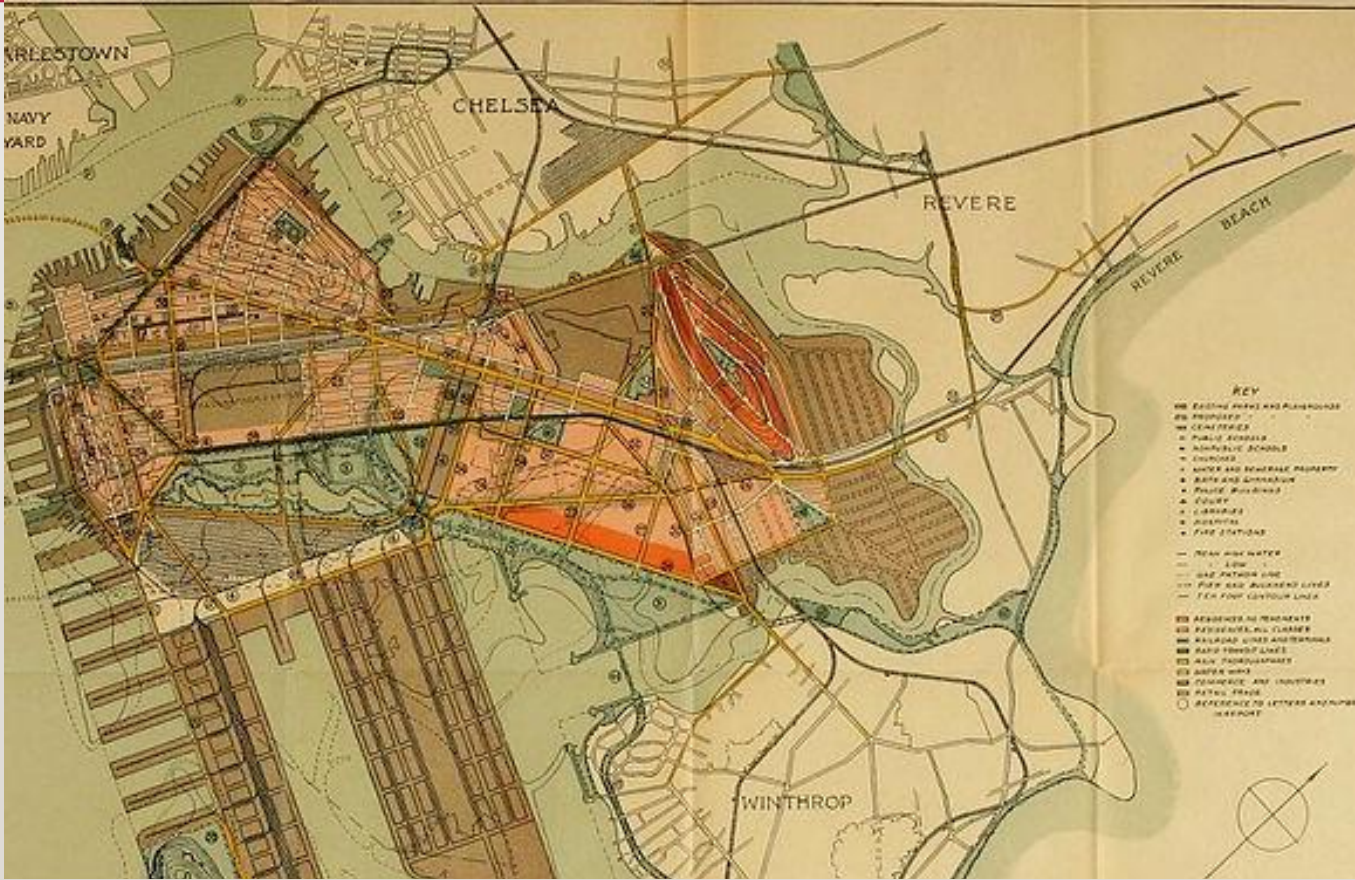
