Update

- 5/8/2023 – CBP started street releases in Cochise County
 - Release Locations and Projections:
 - US Border Patrol – Douglas – 200 daily
 - US Border Patrol – Naco – 200 daily
 - US Customs – Douglas POE – 35 daily
 - US Customs – Naco POE – 12 daily
- 5/8/2023 – AZ DEMA started transportation mission
- 5/11/2023 - Title 42 removals ceased
- 5/19/2023 – Street releases in Cochise County stopped



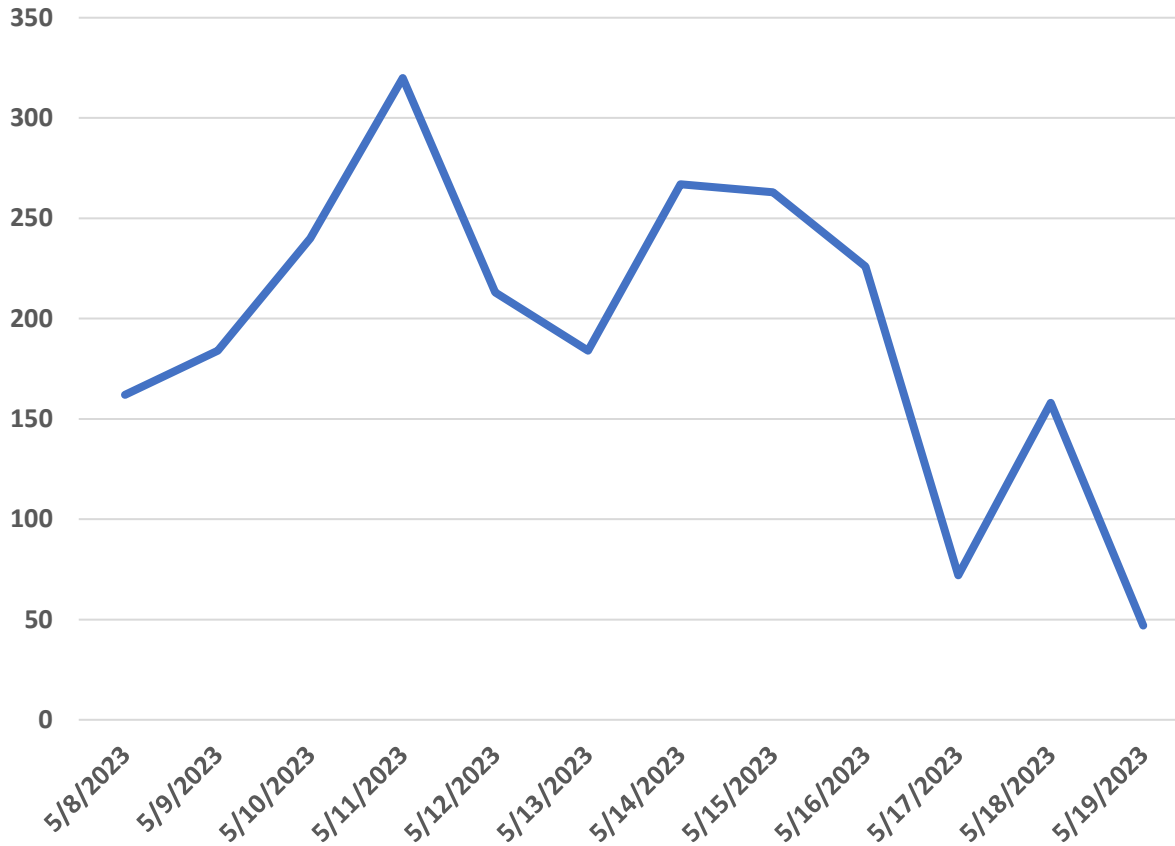
Update

- Street release – release of migrants from CBP custody, currently directly to the DEMA transportation program
- Unsheltered release – a release from CBP in a location with no prearranged transportation or shelter
- There have been no unsheltered releases in Cochise County, all releases have occurred seamless to the DEMA transportation program

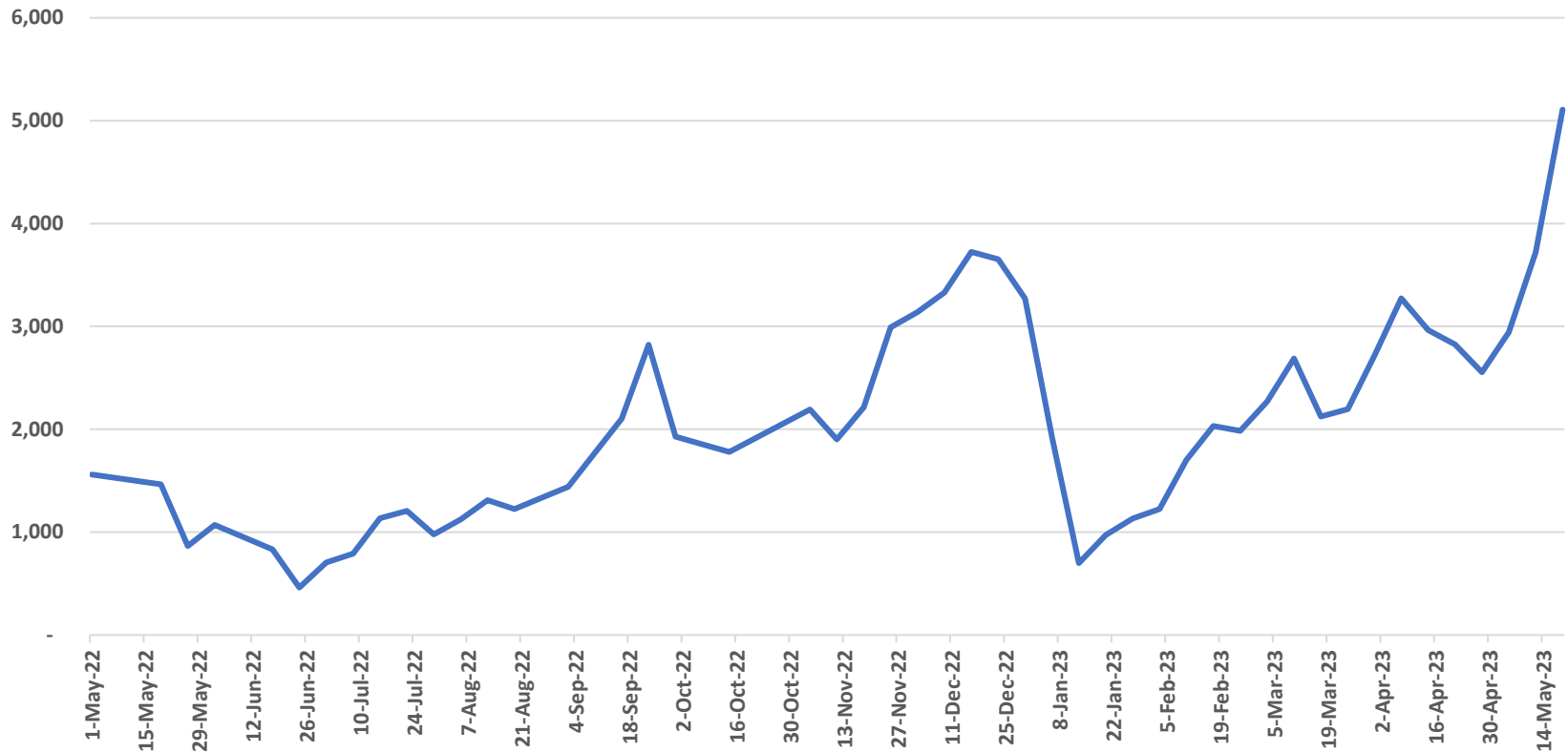

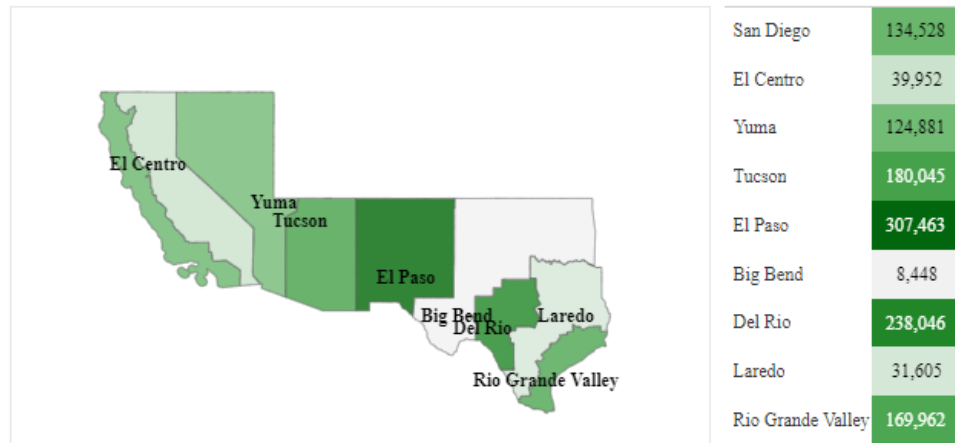
Pima County Arrivals, Weekly
