**RE: Miracle Revival Training Center, a.k.a., Miracle Valley Bible College Tabernacle
Determination of Eligibility to the National and Arizona Registers of Historic Places**

Dear Mr. Coxworth:

Thank you for providing information about the above referenced property in Cochise County. The State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) also received additional documentation on the property prepared by Rebekah Allen Jones, which I share as an attachment for your reference. Staff of the SHPO have reviewed this material and recommended that the property is eligible for listing in the National and Arizona Registers of Historic Places. State Historic Preservation Officer Kathryn Leonard concurred with this recommendation on May 17, 2023.

The Miracle Revival Training Center Tabernacle is eligible under Criterion A in the area of significance of Religion as an important and influential institution within the historic context of American evangelicalism in the post-World War II and Civil Rights eras. The property is also eligible under Criterion B for its association with A.A. Allen as the property most notably associated with his influential ministry. The period of significance is 1958 from Allen's acquisition of land in Arizona to his death in 1970.
