

RESOLUTION 24-02

**AUTHORIZATION TO SUBMIT APPLICATION(S)
AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR
STATE HOUSING FUNDS**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF COCHISE COUNTY, ARIZONA AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION(S) FOR STATE HOUSING FUNDS (WHICH MAY INCLUDE FEDERAL FUNDING THROUGH THE HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM OR STATE HOUSING FUNDS), CERTIFYING THAT SAID APPLICATION(S) MEETS THE COMMUNITY'S HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT NEEDS AND THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE HOUSING PROGRAMS, AND AUTHORIZING ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT AND COMPLETE THE ACTIVITIES OUTLINED IN SAID APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Cochise County, Arizona is desirous of undertaking affordable housing development activities; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona is administering the State Housing Fund Program; and

WHEREAS, the State Housing Fund requires that State Housing Funds benefit low-income households; and

WHEREAS, the activity in the application addresses the community's low-income population housing needs; and

WHEREAS, a recipient of State Housing Funds is required to comply with the program guidelines, State and Federal Statutes and regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Supervisors of Cochise County, Arizona authorize application to be made to the State of Arizona for funding from the State Housing Trust Fund, and authorize the Chair of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors to sign the application and contract or grant documents for receipt and use of these funds, and authorize the Chair of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors to take

all actions necessary to implement and complete the activities submitted in said application; and

THAT, the Board of Supervisors of Cochise County will comply with all State Housing Fund Program Guidelines, State and Federal Statutes and regulations applicable to the State Housing Fund Program (HOME program and/or State Housing Trust Fund) and the certifications contained in the application(s).
