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4. THE PARTIES AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING AMENDMENT

Pursuant to the Agreement Provision 12.0 Amendments, the following is hereby added and modified:

ADD:

35.0 FINGERPRINTING

35.1 The Clerk of the Superior Court shall comply with and shall ensure that all of the Clerk of the Superior Court employees, independent contractors, subcontractors, volunteers and other agents comply with, all applicable (current and future) legal requirements relating to fingerprinting, fingerprint clearance cards, certifications regarding pending or past criminal matters, and criminal records checks that relate to contract performance.

35.2 Applicable legal requirements relating to fingerprinting, certification, and criminal background checks⁷ may include, but are not limited, to the following: A.R.S. §§ 46-141 and I.R.C. §§ 6103 (p)(4)(C). All applicable legal requirements relating to fingerprinting, fingerprint clearance cards, certifications regarding pending or past criminal matters, and criminal records checks are hereby incorporated in their entirety as provisions of this Agreement. The Clerk of the Superior Court is responsible for knowing which legal requirements relating to fingerprinting, fingerprint clearance cards, certifications regarding pending or past criminal matters, and criminal records checks relate to contract performance.

35.3 To the extent A.R.S. § 46-141 is applicable to contract performance or the services provided under this Agreement, the following provisions apply:

35.3.1 Personnel who are employed by the Clerk of the Superior Court, whether paid or not, and who are required or allowed to provide services directly to juveniles or vulnerable adults shall have a valid fingerprint clearance card or shall apply for a fingerprint clearance card within seven working days of employment.

BY SIGNING THIS FORM ON BEHALF OF THE CONTRACTOR, THE SIGNATORY CERTIFIES HE/SHE HAS THE AUTHORITY TO BIND THE CONTRACTOR TO THIS CONTRACT.


INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT DETERMINATION
