Recommendation:

Approve CTR070113 A2, formerly known as CTR063847, CDC Overdose Data to Action (OD2A), between the Arizona Department of Health Services and Cochise Health & Social Services in the amount of \$80,000 for the period of 9/1/2024-8/31/2025.

Background (Brief):

The original Overdose Prevention IGA, CTR070113 beginning FY 2024 was recently approved on June 4, 2024, by the Cochise County Board of Supervisors. While the total amount remains the same, this amendment is being brought forward due to a revision of budget line items.

The approval and funding from this CDC grant will assist CCHSS to address the opioid issues through prevention-based strategies; increase access to overdose prevention tools such as Naloxone, and coordinate post-release transportation services, and increase awareness of local service providers.

Fiscal Impact & Funding Sources:

This is a grant-funded cost reimbursement program through the Arizona Department of Health Services in the amount of \$80,000. Funds are 100% federally funded. This IGA currently funds .75 FTE.

Next Steps/Action Items Follow-Up:

Your approvals are respectfully requested. Program will continue to distribute Naloxone, provide overdose recognition and response trainings.
