Dear Lisa Enriquez, the Cochise County Board of Supervisors and stakeholders:

Ms. Reed is asking the Naco Community to abandon a public owned right of way without describing the need for this abandonment, the benefits to Naco, or why this public right of way should be abandoned.

There is no offer of compensation, nor does she state what she plans to do with this property should it be abandoned.

This abandonment would give public property to a private land owner in a "reverse taking".

Currently, this right of way has deer tracks, birds, javelina tracks, reptiles and other wildlife using this public right of way. It could be a public trail that would be an alternative to a Willson Road walking trail from Camp Naco to Green Bush Draw and other destinations. This would keep walking and bicycle traffic off Willson Road, for a safer right of way that is publicly owned and a benefit to Naco and visitors.

Giving public land to private owners is a bad policy that will not benefit the other residents of Naco, but will enrich private property owners and restrict wildlife and residents.

For these reasons, the Naco Sanitary District opposes this giveaway, and asks the Board of Supervisors to deny this request.
