

# All known and Reported Traffic Accidents: SR 80 Lavender Pit Area Cyclists (2000-2025)

This list includes publicly reported or documented incidents between MP 341.0 and 342.6, including those not captured in ADOT's 2017-2022 spreadsheet but verified through news reports, as well as anecdotal incidents involving serious injuries that were not formally reported.

Keep in mind that many accidents are not reported. In fact, there are at least three that are not included in this summary, involving cyclists:

- [REDACTED] fractured her hip and experienced financial ruin and near foreclosure after being unable to return to her restaurant job.

- [REDACTED] fell into highway traffic and injured her hip while trying to avoid rubble on the path.

- [REDACTED] was hit on his bike and was in a coma for three days after the accident.
