Recommendation:

Approve ADHS IGA CTR067930 A2 - Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) and the Breastfeeding Peer Counselor (BFPC) Program between the Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS) and Cochise County Health & Social Services (CCHSS); in the amount of \$699,050 for WIC and \$63,824 for BFPC for the period of October 1, 2025 – September 30, 2026.

Background (Brief):

CCHSS has offered WIC services for over 30 years to pregnant, breastfeeding, and postpartum women; and infants and children up to the age of 5. The assigned caseload for FFY 26 is 2,980 per month.

The overall goal of the WIC and Breastfeeding Peer Counseling Program is to increase food security, reduce hunger by providing income eligible participants nutrition and breastfeeding education, and access to nourishing food.

Fiscal Impact & Funding Sources:

This is a grant-funded, cost reimbursement program from ADHS in the annual combined amount of \$762,874. The IGA supports wages, EREs, and program expenses for 11 FTEs.
