

Recommendation:

Approve CTR063847, Amendment 3 - Arizona Prescription Drug Overdose Prevention Program, between the Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS) and Cochise County Health & Social Services (CCHSS) in the amount of \$258,509.55 effective 9/30/2025.

Background (Brief):

The original Overdose Prevention Contract with ADHS was approved February 2023. The renewal of this grant funding will continue to support the work of the Overdose Fatality Review Board and strengthen linkages to care for individuals transitioning out of the Cochise County Jail. Funding will enhance services provided by the Public Health Social Worker and Community Health Worker by identifying individual needs, coordinating substance-use treatment upon release, and providing follow up case management and transportation services to support successful recovery and community reentry.

In this Amendment, there has been a slight increase to the budget amount. The deliverables remain the same, with added specificity and metrics for each task.

Fiscal Impact & Funding Sources:

This is a grant-funded cost reimbursement IGA through ADHS in the amount of \$258,509.55. Funds are a combination of federal and state funding. This IGA currently funds 2.60 FTEs.
