<p>Level I For youth newly dispositioned or as a graduated response</p> <p>AZYAS Score</p> <p>Males 14+ Females 12+</p>	<p>Four (4) visual* contacts** per week with the youth</p> <p>In addition, the following is required:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One (1) contact per week with parent/legal guardian • One (1) contact per month with school • One (1) contact per month with employer • One (1) contact per month with treatment provider • Maintain Community Restitution contacts if applicable
<p>Level II For youth actively working on the youth case plan goal-directed objectives or as a graduated response</p> <p>AZYAS Score</p> <p>Males 7 - 13 Females 8 - 11</p>	<p>Two (2) visual* contacts** per week with the youth.</p> <p>In addition, the following is required:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One (1) contact every other week with parent/legal guardian • One (1) contact per month with school • One (1) contact per month with employer • One (1) contact per month with treatment provider • Maintain Community Restitution contacts if applicable
<p>Level III For youth who have completed the majority of the youth case plan goal-directed objectives and to plan for discharge or as a graduated response</p> <p>AZYAS Score:</p> <p>Males 0 - 6 Females 0 - 7</p>	<p>One (1) visual contact** per week with the youth. Two (2) at home contacts per month.</p> <p>In addition, the following is required:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One (1) contact every other week with parent/legal guardian • One (1) contact per month with school • One (1) contact per month with employer • One (1) contact per month with treatment provider • Maintain Community Restitution contacts if applicable
<p>Level IV For youth in Detention</p>	<p>One (1) visual contact** per week with the youth.</p> <p>In addition, the following is required:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One (1) contact every other week with parent/legal guardian • One (1) contact per month with treatment provider

<p>Level V For youth in out-of-home care, out-of-state placement, or in adult jail prior to conviction</p>	<p>One (1) visual contact** per month with the youth.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Via telephone if out of state or adult jail prior to conviction.• One (1) contact per month with parent/legal guardian• One (1) contact per month with treatment provider <p>Upon discharge the JIPS team shall place the youth on the appropriate JIPS supervision level based on the results of the AZYAS disposition tool, the youth's treatment discharge plan, and any other relevant factors.</p>

** Separate days, random/varied times; shall include contact at home, in evenings, on weekends and holidays.
