Level III	Within 72 hours of when a probationer changes residence	1X weekly, at least 1 at residence, every other week; at least 1 collateral every 2 weeks	1 face-to-face with probationer; Additional with collaterals as necessary	Minimum of 1 every 2 weeks with probationer	Minimum of 1/month
Level IV	Within 72 hours of when a probationer changes residence	1X every 2 weeks at residence; at least 1 collateral every 4 weeks	1 face-to-face with probationer; Additional with collaterals as necessary	Minimum of 1 every 2 weeks with probationer	Minimum of 1/month
