

RESOLUTION 26-06

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ADOPTING THE
COCHISE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN (CP2045)**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes §11-804, the Cochise County Board of Supervisors is required to adopt or readopt a Comprehensive Plan to guide the future physical development of the unincorporated areas of the County; and

WHEREAS, County Planning and Zoning Commission with assistance from County staff prepared an updated Comprehensive Plan reflecting the County's long-term vision, goals, and policies for land use, growth, conservation, and community development; and

WHEREAS, the Cochise County Planning and Zoning Commission conducted a duly noticed public hearing on February 11, 2026, and recommended adoption of the Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors held a duly noticed public hearing on March 10, 2026, received public input, and determined that adoption of the Comprehensive Plan promotes the public health, safety, and general welfare of the County's residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Cochise County Board of Supervisors hereby adopts the Cochise County Comprehensive Plan, dated March 10, 2026, and attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A as the official comprehensive planning document for the unincorporated areas of Cochise County, Arizona.

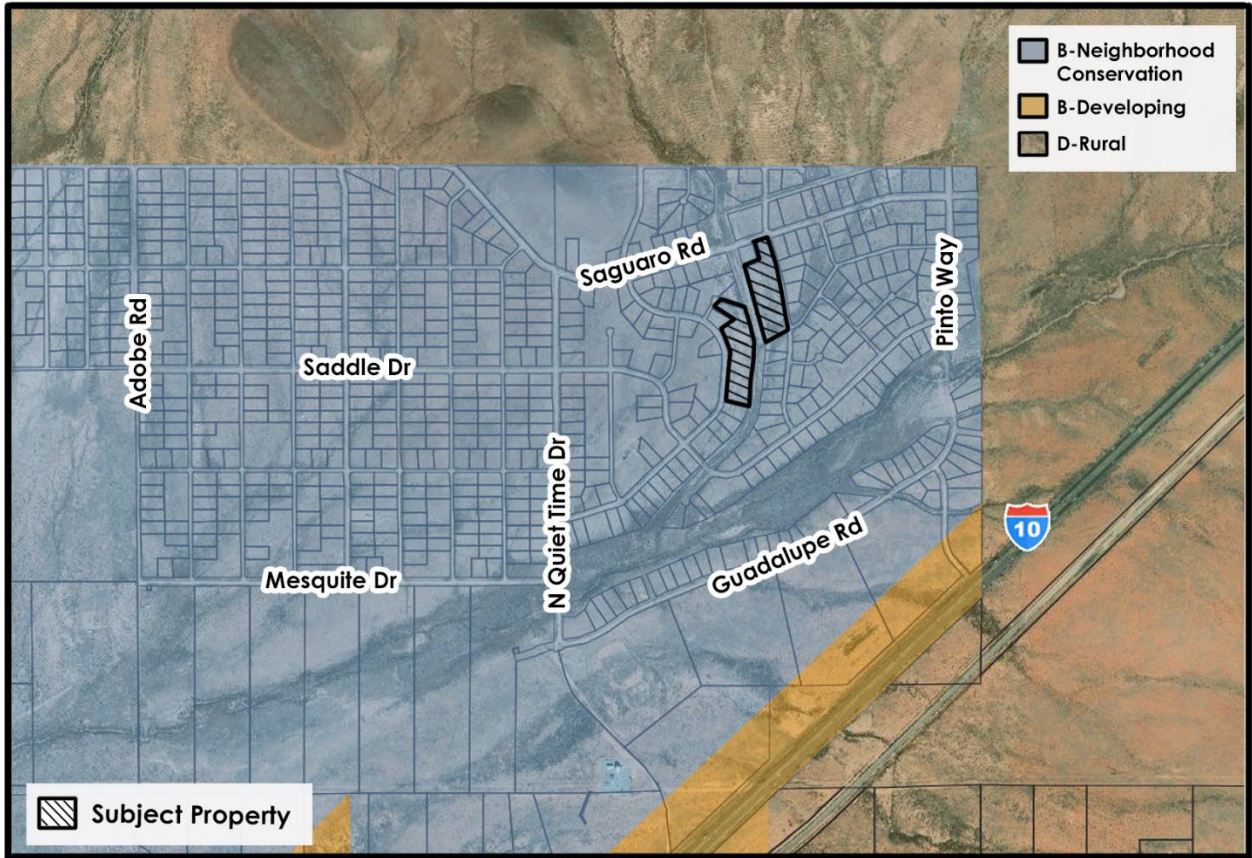
