

**RESOLUTION 26-11**

**DESIGNATING THE CHIEF FISCAL OFFICER  
FOR OFFICIALLY SUBMITTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2027 EXPENDITURE  
LIMITATION REPORT TO THE ARIZONA AUDITOR GENERAL**

**WHEREAS**, A.R.S. §41-1279.07(E) requires each county, city, town, and community college district to annually provide to the Arizona Auditor General by July 31 the name of the Chief Fiscal Officer who the governing body has designated to officially submit the current year's annual expenditure limitation report (AELR) on the governing body's behalf; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cochise County Board of Supervisors desires to designate Monica Miranda as the County's Chief Fiscal Officer; and

**WHEREAS**, Entities must submit an updated form and documentation for any changes in the individuals designated to file the AELR.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY** the Cochise County, Arizona Board of Supervisors as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The recitals above are hereby incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

**SECTION 2.** Monica Miranda is hereby designated as the County's Chief Fiscal Officer for purposes of officially submitting the fiscal year 2027 AELR to the Arizona Auditor General on the governing body's behalf.
