



Age Friendly Public Health Systems (AFPHS)



In December 2025, our department embarked on a journey to be recognized by *Trust for America's Health* as the very first Age Friendly Public Health Department in Arizona. This designation highlights Cochise County's commitment to serving our entire community. To receive this esteemed title, the entire CCHSS staff attended a series of virtual trainings aimed at reducing the stigma when interacting with seniors. We were the first county health department to have every staff member become Age Friendly Public Health Systems Champions.

In addition, we submitted a thorough Action Plan to outline the specifics on meeting the needs of the senior population throughout the county. From targeted educational campaigns to monthly outreach activities, it became our mission to bridge the gap between the generations, ensuring our seniors do not feel left behind.

Adolescent -Well Visits



Currently, our clinical services staff provide sports physicals free for school-aged children once per month.

We are in the process of expanding that program to offer Adolescent-Well Visits for children ages 14-18 when they are already in the clinic for sports physicals.



Sun Safety

Our Health Promotion Chronic Disease Educator is in the process of developing a presentation about the importance of practicing sun safety. She currently presents on hypertension prevention and dementia prevention. This presentation will be provided free of charge for any organization that is interested.

Environmental Health Standards Achievement

Our Environmental Health team is in the process of completing the *Voluntary National Retail Food Regulatory Program Standards* which define what constitutes a highly effective and responsive program for the regulation of foodservice and retail food establishments.

The Retail Program Standards are intended to reinforce proper sanitation (good retail practices) and operational and environmental prerequisite programs while encouraging regulatory agencies and industry to focus on the factors that cause and contribute to foodborne illness, with the ultimate goal of reducing the occurrence of those factors.
