

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR MEETING HELD ON
Tuesday, December 6, 2016**

A regular board meeting of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, December 6, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, 1415 Melody Lane, Building G, Bisbee, Arizona.

Chairman Searle called the meeting to order at 10:12 a.m.

PRESENTATION

Presentation by Ms. Vada Phelps, Executive Director, Southeastern Arizona Workforce Connection, on the status of the partnership and highlights of the annual report.

Ms. Phelps gave an update on the Arizona at Work, Southeastern Arizona, which is the new name for the program. She said the annual report had detailed information and noted she had previously provided that to the Board members. She added that the program was currently working on surveys to find out for what citizens want from the program. She highlighted some new requirements for the program and noted that the Board would be required to participate in the program more than in the past.

The Board thanked Ms. Phelps for her update and her service to this program.

CONSENT

Board of Supervisors

1. Approve the Minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of November 15, 2016.
2. Approve the appointment of Mr. Gerald Muir to the Pollution Control Corporation of the County of Cochise, for a six year term expiring on February 3, 2022, as requested in correspondence from the Pollution Control Corporation dated October 9, 2016.

3. Ratify the adoption of resolution 16-48 regarding the 2017 Legislative Priorities.

County Recorder

4. Approve the request to move \$83,488 from the General Fund contingency line to the Recorder's Office fund lines for printing and postage costs.

County Sheriff

5. Accept and authorize expenditure of additional funds donated by the Howard G. Buffet (HGB) Foundation to the Cochise County Sheriff's Office Financial Crimes Unit in the amount of 388,267.12 to include an additional position and related equipment.
6. Approve Memorandum of Understanding 2016-144 between the Department of Public Safety and the Cochise County Sheriff's Office for a total of \$70,000 to be used for enforcement of immigration, human smuggling, drug smuggling, gangs and employer sanction laws and/or County jail costs relating to illegal immigration.
7. Approve Memorandum of Understanding 2016-162 between the Department of Public Safety and Cochise County in the amount of \$125,000 to be used for prosecutorial and jail expenses incurred from individuals charged with drug trafficking, human smuggling, illegal immigration and other border related crime.

Finance

8. Approve demands and budget amendments for operating transfers. Warrants Nos. 13490-13529, 13540-13770, 13780-13786, 13796-13931 were issued in the amount of \$1,841,339.35

Pursuant to A.R.S. §11-217(C), the published minutes shall include all demands and warrants approved by the Board in excess of one thousand dollars except that multiple demands and warrants from a single supplier or individual under one thousand dollars whose cumulative total exceeds one thousand dollars in a single reporting period shall also be published. Issued warrants are listed as an attachment at the end of the minutes.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to approve items 1-8 on the consent agenda. Supervisor English seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

Community Development

9. Adopt Zoning Ordinance 16-07 amending the text to the Outdoor Storage regulations, Article 18, Section 1811, adding language to permit outdoor storage without a primary use (residence).

Mr. Robert Kirschmann, Planner I, Planning & Zoning Division, Community Development Department, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Kirschmann said that the purpose of the update is to allow limited outdoor storage on properties without a primary use. He noted that the Planning & Zoning Commission voted 6-0 to forward this Docket with a recommendation of approval.

He said that the modifications would include:

Allowing limited storage on vacant residential properties subject to the following standards:

- Storage is limited to equipment specifically for maintenance of roads in the immediate vicinity or the subject parcel
- A minimum lot size of 36,000 square feet is required
- No more than 600 square feet shall be used for equipment storage
- Must meet minimum setback requirements
- One minor change to remove language duplication

The proposed text change:

Section 1811.01.A

Accessory Use Outdoor Storage and parking which is permitted under this Section is an accessory use only and shall not be permitted unless a primary residential use of the property has been established except for limited storage of equipment specifically used for maintenance of roads in the immediate area or the subject parcel itself in Category B, C or D Areas.

Section 1811.01.D

D. Large Trucks, Truck Tractors, Construction Equipment

2. Category B,C and D Areas No primary residential use is required for limited storage of equipment used for maintenance of roads in the immediate area or the subject parcel itself in rural or residential Zoning Districts subject to the following requirements: a. Minimum lot size of 36,000 square feet is required b. No more than 600 square feet of the property shall be used for storage c. The storage shall meet the minimum setbacks of the zoning district

1811.01.B

B. Permitted Visible Outdoor Storage ~~Visible outdoor storage~~ of certain objects and materials shall only be permitted as an accessory use as specified below.

Vice-Chairman Call asked what the term "immediate" would specify in this section.

Mr. Kirschmann said that "immediate" would refer to the adjacent area of the property. He clarified that they did not want those areas to become storage areas.

Vice-Chairman Call suggested the word be changed to adjacent to clarify the purpose.

Chairman Searle opened the public hearing.

No one chose to speak and Chairman Searle closed the public hearing.

Supervisor English moved to adopt Zoning Ordinance 16-07 amending the text to the Outdoor Storage regulations, Article 18, Section 1811, adding language to permit outdoor storage without a primary use (residence). Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

10. Adopt Zoning Ordinance 16-06 to approve Docket R-16-02 for proposed text amendments to the Subdivision Regulations Article 5 Section 501.01(F) Assurance Agreement, adding an additional subsection to include criteria to evaluate a request for an assurance agreement extension.

Mr. Paul Esparza, Planning & Zoning Division Director, Community Development Department, presented this item using a PowerPoint Presentation. Mr. Esparza stated the purpose for the update to the Subdivision regulations was to establish criteria to be used to determine whether an assurance agreement extension should be granted by the Board of Supervisors.

He gave the background:

- The Board of Supervisors has approved 10 assurance agreement extensions since 2010.
- Most assurance agreement extensions have been granted due to unfavorable economic conditions.
- Planning and Zoning Commission voted 6-0 to forward this Docket with a recommendation of approval.

He reviewed the proposed language:

F. The agreement must provide authorization for County to abandon the subdivision final plat and convert the property to unsubdivided land if the required improvements fail to be installed in compliance with the County's standard specifications within three years:

1. The Planning Director, or representative, under authority vested by the Board of Supervisors, may extend the time specified to complete improvements for one (1) year if the purposes of these Regulations would still be served.
2. The Board of Supervisors may extend the time specified to complete improvements for additional terms if the purposes of these Regulations would still be served.
3. The subdivider must demonstrate that progress has been made to complete improvements or that an undue hardship would result.
4. The developer must request an extension before the assurance agreement expires. The determination whether to extend an assurance agreement will be at the sole discretion of the Board of Supervisors, who may consider the following factors in making that determination:
 - i) Whether the property taxes on the subject parcel are current.
 - ii) If the subdivision is phased, whether the subdivision infrastructure improvements for at least 20% of the proposed phases have been completed. If it is not phased, whether at least 25% of the subdivision infrastructure improvements have been completed.
 - iii) The number of extensions previously granted. A maximum of three extensions, not exceeding a total of ten years since either the original approval of the assurance agreement or the most recent release of a lot, whichever has occurred later.
 - iv) The economic conditions or other circumstances that are affecting the developer's ability to complete subdivision improvements.
 - v) Has the character of the area or physical factors such as drainage, floodplain, water issues or circulation patterns changed significantly since plat approval that compliance with current County Subdivision and/or Zoning Regulations is necessary.

Supervisor English said that she did not recall setting a specific percentage.

Mr. Hanson clarified that even with a specific percentage in the regulations; the Board could still make exceptions in certain circumstances.

Vice-Chairman Call asked if this change to the regulation would assist staff in their ability to

explain criteria to the public.

Mr. Esparza said that it would be very helpful and noted that all subdivision files were currently under evaluation to ensure they were covered under the proper requirements.

Chairman Searle opened the public hearing.

No one chose to speak and Chairman Searle closed the public hearing.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to adopt Zoning Ordinance 16-07 amending the text to the Outdoor Storage regulations, Article 18, Section 1811, adding language to permit outdoor storage without a primary use (residence). Supervisor English seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

ACTION

Board of Supervisors

11. Approve the 2017 Cochise County calendar reflecting the schedule of the Regular Board of Supervisor meetings for the calendar year 2017, the 2017 holidays and pay days, and authorize the Clerk to post the Public Notice of the 2017 meeting schedule.

Ms. Arlethe Rios, Clerk of the Board, presented this item. Ms. Rios showed the 2017 calendar and noted that it followed the same schedule as in previous years.

Supervisor English moved to approve the 2017 Cochise County calendar reflecting the schedule of the Regular Board of Supervisor meetings for the calendar year 2017, the 2017 holidays and pay days, and authorize the Clerk to post the Public Notice of the 2017 meeting schedule. Vice-Chairman seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

County Sheriff

12. Accept a donation to Cochise County from the Howard G. Buffett Foundation to build the Southeast Arizona Regional Communication Center in the amount of \$1,734,000.

Sheriff Dannels thanked Supervisor Searle for his years of service.

Sheriff Mark Dannels, Sheriff's Office, presented this item. Sheriff Dannels gave the background and said that over the last four years this project had come to fruition due to the hard work of several County departments. He stated that the donation by the Buffet Foundation would allow the remodel of the building to become an operational reality and open the doors to the regional communications center.

Vice-Chairman Call asked Mr. Vlahovich if he had any concerns with the Board accepting this donation.

Mr. Vlahovich said that he had no concerns as the Finance Department had reviewed the donation and there were no issues.

Supervisor English thanked Mr. Buffet for his generosity and investment into the Cochise County community.

Chairman Searle thanked Sheriff Dannels for his hard work on this project.

Vice-Chairman Call asked about any other conditions that the Board should be aware of, such as unexpended funds or expiration of donation date if the project is not finished.

Sheriff Dannels said he was not aware of any special conditions, but assured the Board that he would work with the Buffet Foundation if any issues came up.

Supervisor English moved to accept a donation to Cochise County from the Howard G. Buffett Foundation to build the Southeast Arizona Regional Communication Center in the amount of \$1,734,000. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

Facilities

13. Approve an increase in the amount of \$307,271 to the Bisbee Douglas International Airport (BDI) water system improvement budget to account for additional outer perimeter line replacement.

Mr. Jay Howe, Facilities Director, presented this item. Mr. Howe gave the background, noted the benefits, and went over costs.

Ms. Nike Noack, Financial Services Manager, said there was a contingency built in if needed, but staff did not think that the full amount would be used for the project.

Supervisor English moved to approve an increase in the amount of \$307,271 to the Bisbee Douglas International Airport (BDI) water system improvement budget to account for additional outer perimeter line replacement. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.
