PRESENTATION

24. Approve revisions to the Cochise County Merit System Rules and Human Resources Policy Manual to be effective December 20, 2016.

25. Approve the National School Grant Program (NSGP) by the Arizona Department of Education for the replacement of kitchen equipment in the amount of \$12,006.62 for the period of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017.

Procurement

26. Approve the sale of one used cell phone declared surplus by the Procurement Department Property Manager for the amount of \$65.

Workforce Development

27. Approve Amendment #6 to Title IB Adult, Youth, and Dislocated Worker contract DI16-002121 between Cochise County and the Arizona Department of Economic Security for the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Service Delivery Area from April 1, 2015 to June 30, 2018 in the amount of \$300,494.

Supervisor English moved to approve items 5 - 27 on the consent agenda. Vice-Chairman Call seconded and it carried unanimously.

ACTION

Community Development

28. Approve the Highway Department application to the Federal Railroad Administration for change of status of railroad crossings in Bowie and Dragoon to Quiet Zones, based on cost estimates for required upgrades to both crossings in the not to exceed amount of \$67,000.

Ms. Karen Riggs, Highway & Floodplain Director, presented this item. Ms. Riggs said Chairman Searle was initially approached by the citizens of Bowie and later by Dragoon. Since Bowie and Dragoon are both in unincorporated areas the County would have to be the sponsor for both of these quiet zones; taking responsibility for upgrading the crossing to the standards of the Federal Railway Administrator and users of the railroad line. After a Work Session with the Board, and direction to move forward, there was a field trip with officials to the site. ACIP said if the County met the federal requirements the additional liability for sponsoring was not substantial. Ms. Riggs showed the quiet zone locations and where the creation of a 100' concrete median, skirting, striping and signs would be located. The cost estimate to meet requirements is \$67,000 for both, and funding is available outside of HURF for the installation. Staff recommended approval. If approved by the Board, staff will send the design to the federal railroad for approval. After their approval, if the installation costs goes over 5% of the cost estimate, staff will bring back to the Board.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to approve the Highway Department application to the Federal Railroad Administration for change of status of railroad crossings in Bowie and Dragoon to Quiet Zones, based on cost estimates for required upgrades to both crossings in the not to exceed amount of \$67,000. Supervisor English seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

29. Adopt Resolution 16-49 authorizing the addition of 1.49 miles of Bascom Trail from Cattle Drive to Indian Trail to the Cochise County Maintained Road System.

Ms. Karen Riggs, Highway & Floodplain Director, presented this item. Staff recommended this addition as part of the Drop/Add program administered by the Highways Department. District 3 has plenty of miles to add because of miles that have been dropped. She described the addition area: 1.49 miles in Kansas Settlement; close to the volunteer Fire Department and residents. They have checked the policy requirements, and there is plenty of right-of-way. If approved the fence would be moved back. The addition would be considered primitive with an occasional grading for maintenance. Chairman Searle said the drive for the creation of the Drop/Add program was the discovery of eight miles of maintained roads with no residents, and since its implementation 12 years ago, it has been very successful.

Supervisor English amended the motion to adopt Resolution 16-49 authorizing the addition of 1.49 miles of Bascom Trail from Cattle Drive to Indian Trail to the Cochise County Maintained Road System and designated as primitive. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

County Sheriff

30. Approve Stone Garden contract number 160400-02 with the Department of Homeland Security (DOHS) in the amount of \$935,000 for overtime and mileage to participate in the operation to detect, deter and/or arrest subjects who smuggle human or drugs illegally into the country effective November 1, 2016 through December 31, 2017.

Sheriff Mark Dannels congratulated Commander Genz on his years of service.

This item was presented by Sheriff Mark Dannels. He gave an overview of the federally funded grant program that is provided annually to the four border counties in Arizona to cover overtime and equipment in order to combat human/drug trafficking and associated crimes. He listed the benefits: Increased enforcement/patrol with 24/7 coverage; higher quality of service to the citizens of Cochise County by enabling the CCSO to specifically deal with ongoing crimes and issues associated to the border; reimburses overtime, employee related expenses (ERE) and pays .445 cents a mile for vehicle use; overtime equivalents of 8.1 deputies; listed statistics of traffic stops, citations and arrests; recovery of stolen vehicles; apprehension of undocumented aliens, marijuana and other drug seizures; and listed statistics from the juvenile defenders' program. He concluded with the support Stone Garden adds to the County making it an Anti-Smuggling County and Public Safety Retirement System (PSPRS) benefits and asked for the Board's support.

Supervisor English commented that for six years she has been asking about the effectiveness of this program and what is reported to the federal government and this is the first report she has seen.

Mr. Scott Arena, Cochise County citizen spoke in favor of Stone Garden.

Mr. Vlahovich said he met with Mr. Gilligan and asked Finance to prepare an analysis of the current PSPRS status in order maintain/improve the financial viability of the PSPRS program. He recommended Stone Garden funds be used for individuals with less than five years in the PSPRS program in order to lessen the impact on the retirement system. Participants need to be managed to help make the unfunded liability to the County as harmless as possible.

Supervisor English said the public needs to understand that the grant pays for itself today but the concern is the future impact on Cochise County when the participant retires. We need to be

fiscally responsible not only now but for the future. The Sheriff's Office has tried to mitigate this issue by limiting the amount of overtime hours.

Sheriff Dannels agrees with the management but not necessarily the five year designation in order for his office to work as a team. His department is committed to be fiscally responsible while working within their mission. He added there has not been an adjustment in deputy's salaries in the last 11 years and how far behind we are when compared to the City of Sierra Vista. Stone Garden is a good thing for Cochise County based on the compensation package.

Chairman Searle said the County and the Sheriff's Office need to work together to manage and solve this issue and it is paying its own way at this time.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to approve Stone Garden contract number 160400-02 with the Department of Homeland Security (DOHS) in the amount of \$935,000 for overtime and mileage to participate in the operation to detect, deter and/or arrest subjects who smuggle human or drugs illegally into the country effective November 1, 2016 through December 31, 2017. Supervisor English seconded the motion.

Vice-Chairman commented he will certainly vote for Stone Garden, but is weary with the back and forth, without much movement forward in resolving the PSPRS issue and he will make this issue a priority in the future.

Supervisor English added that she is not the only one questioning Stone Garden and we need to work together for a win/win situation for both the County and the Sheriff's Office.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

Court Administration

31. Approve the Court Consolidation Agreement between Cochise County and the City of Willcox, effective July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2019.

Chairman Searle asked that items 31 through 35 be presented at once but voted on separately.

Ms. Nike Noack, Financial Services Manager presented this item. Ms. Noack stated that four of the five agreements are renewals with the exception being the City of Douglas which is new. Most of the agreements had expired and the language of all have been standardized with minor changes. The jail cost has been eliminated based on statutes; and details added on how fees are calculated. The City of Benson includes special prosecutor information and the City of Douglas has a different effective date.

Mr. Vlahovich acknowledged Ms. Noack, Mr. Hanson and Mr. Conlogue's hard work on these agreements that have been thoroughly vetted.

Supervisor English made a motion to approve the Court Consolidation Agreement between Cochise County and the City of Willcox, effective July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2019. Vice-Chairman Call seconded and the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

32. Approve the Court Consolidation Agreement between Cochise County and the City of Bisbee, effective July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2019.

Vice-Chairman Call made a motion to approve the Court Consolidation Agreement between Cochise County and the City of Bisbee, effective July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2019. Supervisor English seconded and the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

33. Approve the Court Consolidation Agreement between Cochise County and the City of Benson, effective July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2019.

Supervisor English made a motion to approve the Court Consolidation Agreement between Cochise County and the City of Benson, effective July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2019. Vice-Chairman Call seconded and the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

34. Approve the Court Consolidation Agreement between Cochise County and the City of Douglas, effective January 1, 2017 through June 30, 2019 to include a court assistant position with an annual cost of \$35,120.

Vice-Chairman Call made a motion to approve the Court Consolidation Agreement between Cochise County and the City of Douglas, effective January 1, 2017 through June 30, 2019 to include a court assistant position with an annual cost of \$35,120. Supervisor English seconded and the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

35. Approve the Court Consolidation Agreement between Cochise County and the City of Sierra Vista, effective January 1, 2017 through June 30, 2019.

Supervisor English made a motion to approve the Court Consolidation Agreement between Cochise County and the City of Sierra Vista, effective July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2019. Vice-Chairman Call seconded and the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

Facilities

36. Approve the award of Invitation For Bids (IFB) No. 17-07-FAC-04 for the renovation and construction of the Southeast Arizona Regional Communication Center (SEACOM) facility to D Square Construction, LLC in the amount of \$1,607,112 which includes tax.

Mr. Terry Hudson, Procurement Director presented item as the lowest bid. There were two local bids received but the local vendor preference is not allowed for construction project bids. There was a discussion about the delays in the selection of the contractor and projections for completion of construction among the Board, Mr. Hudson and Sheriff Alinen.

Chairman Searle asked about rewards/penalties for contractors. Mr. Vlahovich said they will implement those procedures for future contracts.

Supervisor English thanked Mr. Buffett for his generosity in funding this project.

Vice-Chairman Call made a motion to approve the award of Invitation For Bids (IFB) No. 17-07-FAC-04 for the renovation and construction of the Southeast Arizona Regional Communication Center (SEACOM) facility to D Square Construction, LLC in the amount of \$1,607,112 which includes tax. Supervisor English seconded and the motion.

Vice-Chairman Call said he appreciated all the work and effort on this project and congratulated everyone.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

37. Approve Amendment No. 8 to Arizona Department of Corrections Agreement No. 090098DC extending the Lease Agreement 7044 to June 30, 2017 with the Arizona State Department of Corrections Facilities for the Water System Improvement Project for a payment of \$242,000 to the County.

Ms. Noack presented this item to allow the County to continue operations while drafting a long term agreement with the DOC. She discussed the current and future rates and terms of the contract.

Supervisor English recognized and thanked Mr. Chuck Ryan for securing the funds for this project.

Supervisor English made a motion to approve Amendment No. 8 to Arizona Department of Corrections Agreement No. 090098DC extending the Lease Agreement 7044 to June 30, 2017 with the Arizona State Department of Corrections Facilities for the Water System Improvement Project for a payment of \$242,000 to the County. Vice-Chairman Call seconded and the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

Human Resources

38. Adopt the new Workplace Violence Prevention Policy, Confidentiality Policy and revisions to the Policy Controlling Access to and Use of County Vehicles and Equipment (repealing any previous versions) to be effective February 1, 2017.

Ms. Julie Morales, Human Resources Director presented this item. She said after the Work Session covering these policies minor changes were incorporated. There were no additional questions from the Board.

Vice-Chairman Call made a motion to approve the new Workplace Violence Prevention Policy, Confidentiality Policy and revisions to the Policy Controlling Access to and Use of County Vehicles and Equipment (repealing any previous versions) to be effective February 1, 2017. Supervisor English seconded and the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

CALL TO THE PUBLIC

This is the time for the public to comment. Members of the Board may not discuss items that are not specifically identified on the agenda.

Commander Genz spoke in regards to his retirement after 21 years of service. He thanked the Sheriff's Office for the opportunity and also the Board and staff. He asked that the Sheriff's Office be recognized for their efforts and supports taxes in order for all County employees to be compensated. He asked the Board to consider paying employees vacation and sick leave at the end of the year in lieu of losing that time. He thanked everyone for their support over the years and unveiled the department's new flag.

Mr. John Ladd was happy about the approval of Stone Garden and brought up the cost of illegal immigration. He congratulated the Board and the Sheriff's Office on their efforts for the County, and Chairman Searle on his retirement.
