Approve Amendment #7 to Title IB Adult, Youth, and Dislocated Worker contract DI16-002121 between Cochise County and the Arizona Department of Economic Security for the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Service Delivery Area from April 1, 2015 to June 30, 2019 in the amount of \$1,870,141.
7. Approve a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), amendment 1 between Cochise, Graham, and Greenlee counties for the operation of the Arizona at Work Southeastern Arizona Local Workforce Development One-Stop Service delivery system as required by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) effective July 1, 2017 through May 31, 2017.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to approve items 1-7 on the consent agenda. Supervisor Judd seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

Board of Supervisors

8. Approve an interim permit/new liquor license application submitted by Ms. Ayana Danielle Malarchik, for The Outside Inn, located at 4907 South Highway 92, Sierra Vista, AZ 85635.

Ms. Arlethe Rios, Clerk of the Board, presented this item. Ms. Rios said the Sheriff's Office did not have a recommendation and that the Planning and Zoning Department had recommended approval. The Environmental Health Division noted that they have no concerns with the issuance of the liquor license; the Treasurer's Office noted that the property taxes are current after the Board office made contact with the applicant. The Board staff recommended approval.

Chairman English opened the public hearing.

No one chose to speak and Chairman English closed the public hearing.

Supervisor Judd moved to approve an interim permit/new liquor license application submitted by Ms. Ayana Danielle Malarchik, for The Outside Inn, located at 4907 South Highway 92, Sierra Vista, AZ 85635. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

ACTION

Board of Supervisors

9. Approve the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between Cochise County, and the cities of Benson, Bisbee, Douglas, Sierra Vista, Tombstone and Willcox to update the responsibilities of the Cochise County Tourism Steering Committee in the amount of \$34,165 for the period of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2020.

Mr. Gilligan presented this item. He noted that the main change to this existing IGA was to shift the responsibility of fiscal agent to the City of Sierra Vista and added that all the entities would be working together to restructure the mission of the group and ensure maximum return on all the entities' investments.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to approve the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between Cochise County, and the cities of Benson, Bisbee, Douglas, Sierra Vista, Tombstone and Willcox to update the responsibilities of the Cochise County Tourism Steering Committee in the amount of

\$34,165 for the period of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2020. Supervisor Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

10. Adopt Resolution 17-12 to approve the Intergovernmental Agreement between Cochise County ("County") and the City of Sierra Vista ("City") for Regional 911 Communications and establishment of the Southeastern Arizona Communications Center (SEACOM).

Mr. Gilligan presented this item. He said it was a new agreement and that the IGA had been the product of many months of work with different entities to partner in this effort.

Mr. Hanson stated that all details were discussed thoroughly at the work session and that there were only two changes made since the work session: three year renewal was changed to five year renewal with automatic annual renewals; and they do not think the first part of fiscal year will provide enough data to figure costs for subscribers.

Vice-Chairman Call asked who would decide to accept new entities.

Mr. Hanson said that the decision to accept new entities would be up to the SEACOM Board.

Supervisor Judd moved to adopt Resolution 17-12 to approve the Intergovernmental Agreement between Cochise County ("County") and the City of Sierra Vista ("City") for Regional 911 Communications and establishment of the Southeastern Arizona Communications Center (SEACOM). Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

11. Approve the issue of the Elected Official Retirement Pension (EORP) excess contributions to the Superior Court judges in the amount of \$134,667.75 and the issue of the pre-judgment interest refunds to the applicable EORP members in the amount of \$57,623.53 and post-judgment interest of \$311.40.

Ms. Lynette Nowlan, Finance Director, presented this item. Ms. Nowlan stated that the Board had previously approved most of EORP and PSPRS refunds as a result of the two court case decisions. She stated that the item being discussed today was to address the refunds of superior court judges and to issue interest payments for all members of the EORP. She added that the superior court judge payments would be made up front and then the State would reimburse the County. She also said that she was still awaiting the interest amount for the PSPRS personnel and that the total PSPRS cost would most likely be three times the amount paid today.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to approve the issue of the Elected Official Retirement Pension (EORP) excess contributions to the Superior Court judges in the amount of \$134,667.75 and the issue of the pre-judgment interest refunds to the applicable EORP members in the amount of \$57,623.53 and post-judgment interest of \$311.40. Supervisor Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

12. Approve the over-the-counter sale of tax deed properties as set forth in the attached Exhibit A, plus related administrative fees.

Ms. Rios presented this item. She said that there had been one bid received for one parcel for a total sale of \$5,075 (\$5,000 for the bid and \$75 for the administrative fee). She added that the parcel had originally been removed from the auction list at the request of the Highway Division and after discussion with the bidder the Highway Division decided the best interest of the County

was to sell the parcel and put it back on the tax rolls.

Supervisor Judd moved to approve the over-the-counter sale of tax deed properties as set forth in the attached Exhibit A, plus related administrative fees. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

County Schools

13. [ITEM TABLED FROM JULY 11, 2017 MEETING]: Adopt Resolution 17-09 declaring Apache Elementary School District #42 lapsed, attaching the territory to Douglas Unified School District #27, disposing of district property and providing for payment of debts.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to remove the item from the table. Supervisor Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

Ms. Jaqui Clay, County School Superintendent, (telephonically) respectfully requested that the Board withdraw the request and remove the item from the agenda. She added that eight families had submitted written commitments to enroll students in this school district.

Chairman English removed it from the agenda.

Health & Social Services

14. Approve the Arizona Department of Health Services IGA #ADHS17-133164 for the Emergency Preparedness Program, between the Arizona Department of Health Services and Cochise Health & Social Services, in the amount of \$237,293 effective July 1, 2017 and ending June 30, 2018.

Mr. Greg McQuaide, Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP) Director, presented this item. Mr. McQuaide said the grant was for the continuation of the PHEP program, which focused on public health emergency preparedness: response, prevention, and education.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to approve the Arizona Department of Health Services IGA #ADHS17-133164 for the Emergency Preparedness Program, between the Arizona Department of Health Services and Cochise Health & Social Services, in the amount of \$237,293 effective July 1, 2017 and ending June 30, 2018. Supervisor Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.
