CALL TO THE PUBLIC

Chairman English opened the call to the public.

No one chose to speak and Chairman English closed the call to the public.

This is the time for the public to comment. Members of the Board may not discuss items that are not specifically identified on the agenda.

PRESENTATION

Presentation of Proclamation to Mr. Livingston Sutro, Chair of the National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) of Southeastern Arizona declaring September 30, 2017 to be National Alliance on Mental Illness Awareness Day in Cochise County.

Mr. Livingston went over the events to bring awareness to this cause.

The Board presented the proclamation and wished Mr. Sutro success with his event.

1. Approve the Minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of August 22, 2017.

2. Approve a Proclamation declaring September 30, 2017 to be National Association of Mental Illness Awareness Day in Cochise County.
3. Adopt Resolution 17-18 accepting a grant from the Gila River Indian Nation as a pass through for the Sunsites-Pearce Fire District in the amount of \$11,000.
4. Approve acceptance of Quit Claim Deed from Mary A. Blake (Grantor) to Cochise County for real property described as Lots 8, 9, and 10 in Block 641 of Arizona Sun Sites, Unit No. 5, as recorded in Book 4 of Maps and Plats, page 83, records of Cochise County, Arizona and; Lots 11 and 12 in Block 370 of Arizona Sun Sites, Unit No. 3, as recorded in Book 4 of Maps and Plats, page 52, records of Cochise County, Arizona as recommended by the Highway & Floodplain Division.

9. Adopt Resolution 17-19 to approve the Cochise County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan 2017 as required by the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000.

Finance

10. Approve demands and budget amendments for operating transfers. Warrants Nos. 20131-20211, 20215-20408, 20420-20491 were issued in the amount of \$1,585,264.66.

Human Resources

11. Approve the appointments of Ms. Liz York and Ms. Donna Hilton to the Cochise County Merit Commission commencing September 12, 2017 and ending September 11, 2021.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to approve items 1-11 on the consent agenda. Supervisor Judd seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

ACTION

Board of Supervisors

12. Approve the award of Invitation for Bid 17-32-BOS-03 for Southern Arizona Children's Haven Arson Remediation Repair to B-R Constructors Inc. in the amount of \$119,119 and four possible Add Alternates in the amount of \$45,981.00 for a total of \$165,100.

Ms. Maria Morales, Senior Buyer, Procurement Department, presented this item. Ms. Morales gave the background and noted that the company used for this was local.

Supervisor Judd moved to approve the award of Invitation for Bid 17-32-BOS-03 for Southern Arizona Children's Haven Arson Remediation Repair to B-R Constructors Inc. in the amount of \$119,119 and four possible Add Alternates in the amount of \$45,981.00 for a total of \$165,100. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

13. Approve Contract between the SouthEastern Arizona Governments Organization (SEAGO) and Cochise County for technical assistance for the completion of the Southern Arizona Children's Haven Project, granted through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) in fiscal year 2016-17 in the amount of \$16,831.

Mr. Gilligan presented this item. Mr. Gilligan said that this request was made so that SEAGO could take over the management of the remaining duties for CDBG due to the grants management position with the County becoming vacant. He noted that SEAGO had done this type of grant for many years and they could continue to oversee this project successfully. He added that there would be no cost to the County as the CDBG grant has monies allotted to pay for administration fees, which in this case would go to SEAGO for taking over the management of the grant.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to approve Contract between the South Eastern Arizona Governments Organization (SEAGO) and Cochise County for technical assistance for the completion of the Southern Arizona Children's Haven Project, granted through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) in fiscal year 2016-17 in the amount of \$16,831. Supervisor Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

Community Development

14. Approve Final Plat and Assurance Agreement for completion of Subdivision Improvements, Docket S-16-01 for The Highlands at Inde Final Plat Lots 1-10, Tract 1, Common Area "A" with Pioneer Title Agency as trustee under trust number 70100206.

Mr. Paul Esparza, Planning Manager, Planning and Zoning Division, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Esparza gave the background:

- This request is for approval of a Minor Expedited Final Plat for The Highlands at Inde, Lots 1-10, Tract 1 and Common Area "A" with flexible lot sizes and no density bonus.
- This final plat is a 10 lot subdivision on 45.27 acres, with an average lot size of 3.6 acres.
- The subject parcels APN 209-86-022A and 209-86-024C are currently zoned RU-4. Growth Area: D Plan Designation: Rural currently zoned RU-4. Growth Area: D Plan Designation: Rural
- The site is located approximately 8 miles west of the City of Willcox.
- The P&Z Commission unanimously recommended approval of the Final Plat with staff conditions on August 9, 2017.
- The developer will record CC&Rs for the subdivision.
- Access to the subdivision will be from Airport Road, the nearest access to Interstate 10 is via Taylor Road.
- The subdivision will have private internal roads. The roads will be built to low volume design standards and will be maintained by the HOA. The Drainage Report has been approved with the floodplain.
- The Drainage Report has been approved with the floodplain delineated on the final plat.
- Each lot will have an individual sewage disposal system, with a conventional septic tank and leach field.
- Water to the subdivision lots will be provided by a shared well.

He showed a map of the area, copy of the final plat, and where access would be for the subdivision. He stated that staff recommended approval as the proposed final plat did comply with subdivision requirements and there were no factors against the subdivision.

Chairman English asked if Taylor Road would be maintained.

Mr. Esparza said that Taylor Road was already in the County's Road Maintenance System.

He also listed the conditions of approval:

- All private roads shall remain private and will be maintained by the HOA and will not be maintained by Cochise County in the future as noted on the final plat.
- Prior to construction, the ADEQ Certificate of Approval to Construct the water delivery system shall be submitted to the County Engineer.
- The developer has submitted a third party trust agreement to ensure completion of all subdivision improvements with a condition for the partial release of four lots for sale, however no building permits will be issued or reviewed prior to the completion of all subdivision improvements.
- Prior to building construction, each subdivision lot shall have a septic permit approval.
- Construction of improvements shall not begin until a completed Notice of Intent and authorization number, granted by ADEQ for the Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan is received by the Community Development Department.
- The access easement for the well site shall be recorded.
- All County Fire Official and Willcox Rural Fire Department requirements regarding fire sprinkler systems and fire water storage shall be met.
- The entry code for any gated entry shall be provided to all emergency service providers

and county building safety staff.

Mr. CJ Gorland, President, said he did not have an exact timeline, but the interest was very high.

Supervisor Judd moved to approve Final Plat and Assurance Agreement for completion of Subdivision Improvements, Docket S-16-01 for The Highlands at Inde Final Plat Lots 1-10, Tract 1, Common Area "A" with Pioneer Title Agency as trustee under trust number 70100206.

Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

County Sheriff

15. Approve Grant Agreement HT-17-2727 for the Drug, Gang, and Violent Crime Control funding with the Arizona Criminal Justice Commission in the amount of \$157,700 for overtime salaries and fringe benefits (ERE) effective January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2018.

Chairman English noted that this item was requested to be removed from the agenda by the Sheriff's Office.

Court Administration

16. Approve appointment of Gary W. Ramaeker to serve as Justice of the Peace Pro Tempore for Justice Court Precinct 5 as authorized under A.R.S. §22-121 for a term commencing on September 12, 2017 to and including June 30, 2018, and approve his appointment as Juvenile Hearing Officer as authorized under A.R.S. §8-323.

Ms. Niltza Flores, Court Division Director, presented this item. Ms. Flores said that with a staff retirement it was necessary to appoint another judge to cover as a back up for the justice courts.

Chairman English asked why the term was for a short period of time.

Ms. Flores said that the time period covered the remainder of the term.

Supervisor Judd moved to approve appointment of Gary W. Ramaeker to serve as Justice of the Peace Pro Tempore for Justice Court Precinct 5 as authorized under A.R.S. §22-121 for a term commencing on September 12, 2017 to and including June 30, 2018, and approve his appointment as Juvenile Hearing Officer as authorized under A.R.S. §8-323. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

Facilities

17. Approve the award of Invitation for Bid (IFB) No. 17-26-FAC-04 for Improvements to the Bisbee Douglas International Airport Reconstruct Taxiway A for the Facilities Management Department to Pavex Corporation in the amount of \$673,025.

Mr. Jay Howe, Facilities Director, presented this item. Mr. Howe gave the background and noted that the Board had already accepted the grant and now that the bid process was completed staff was prepared to award the project, which would save money that would be used to fund inspection services.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to approve the award of Invitation for Bid (IFB) No. 17-26-FAC-04 for

Improvements to the Bisbee Douglas International Airport Reconstruct Taxiway A for the Facilities Management Department to Pavex Corporation in the amount of \$673,025. Supervisor Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

REPORT BY EDWARD T. GILLIGAN COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR -- RECENT AND PENDING COUNTY MATTERS

Mr. Gilligan stated that Ms. Lisa Marra had been appointed to Elections and Special Districts Director. He said that with a vacancy in economic development and tourism he was transferring those duties to the Housing Director Anita Baca. He added that other duties previously done by Ms. Marra would be taken by the Clerk of the Board and her staff.

SUMMARY OF CURRENT EVENTS

Report by District 1 Supervisor, Patrick Call

Vice-Chairman Call said he had attended the Sierra Vista Metropolitan Planning Organization (SVMPO) meeting and hosted Fort Huachuca's commanding general on his radio show, which would feature several community leaders. He added that he had attended the Naco Border Patrol Station Stakeholder's Meeting and was told by the officer in charge of this area that the numbers of illegal immigrants crossing was very low.

Report by District 2 Supervisor, Ann English

Chairman English thanked Vice-Chairman Call for coordinating the Fort Huachuca's Commanding General Tour of the County last Friday and she thanked the Board for their interest and support of the Commercial Port project in Douglas. She added that she had recently been gifted a portrait of Governor Castro by the Mexican Counsel and it would be available to be viewed in the Douglas Regional Service Center.

Report by District 3 Supervisor, Peggy Judd

Supervisor Judd said she had attended the Arizona/Sonora Council meeting and the University of Arizona Cooperative Extension Board Meeting. She encouraged citizens to attend the upcoming Rex Allen Days in Willcox and Butterfield Days in Benson.

Chairman English adjourned the meeting at 10:47 a.m.
