

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

CALL TO THE PUBLIC

Chairman English opened the call to the public.

Jack Cook addressed the Board on matters of personal concern.

No one else chose to speak and Chairman English closed the call to the public.

This is the time for the public to comment. Members of the Board may not discuss items that are not specifically identified on the agenda.

PRESENTATION

Presentation by Catherine Traywick, Cochise County Treasurer to the Board of Supervisors of two Arizona Association of Counties (AACo) awards. The Summit Award for Community and Economic Development, and the Merit Award for Public-Private Partnership Award, both for the Horseshoe Draw Erosion Project.

Ms. Traywick presented the Board with two AACo Awards the County received for the Horseshoe Draw Erosion Project.

The Board congratulated Ms. Traywick on her recent election as President of AACo and thanked her for representing the County and collecting the awards.

Chairman English welcomed representatives from the Hereford Natural Resource Conservation District

(NRCD) and Ms. Karen Riggs, Highway & Floodplain Director, and thanked them for their part in the public/private partnership.

Workforce Development

7. Approve the appointments of Ms. Wendy Davis and Mr. Tony Boone to the Local Workforce Development Board to fill an unexpired term, effective immediately and through 6/30/2021.

Supervisor Judd moved to approve items 1-7 on the consent agenda. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

Community Development

8. Adopt Zoning Ordinance 17-05 amending the text to Article 17, Administration and Article 22 Amendments of the Cochise County Zoning Regulations to modify notice requirements to neighbors for special use permits and re-zonings.

Mr. Robert Kirschmann, Planner II, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Kirschmann gave the background on the process for the recommended changes:

- July and September, 2017 Board Work Sessions
- October 11, 2017 Planning and Zoning Commission Work Session
- November 8, 2017 Planning and Zoning Hearing

He noted that the Planning and Zoning Commission had approved the four changes to the regulations and reviewed the four changes:

- Section 1716.03, Special Use Authorization
- Section 1716.04, Appeal of Special Use Authorization
- Section 2203, Citizen Review Process
- Section 2206, Planning Commission Action Re-zonings

He also reviewed the Plan Growth Areas:

- Growth Area A: Urban Infill in Sierra Vista
- Growth Area B: Urbanizing Areas
- Growth Area C: Rural Communities Comp Plan Growth Areas
- Growth Area D: Rest of County ~ 85%

He noted that these would be increased in rural communities to ensure proper notification for those citizens who have large properties and live further apart. He added that the section specifying the exact distances would be turned into a more readable document for citizens.

Chairman English opened the public hearing.

No one chose to speak and Chairman English closed the public hearing.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to adopt Zoning Ordinance 17-05 amending the text to Article 17, Administration and Article 22 Amendments of the Cochise County Zoning Regulations to modify notice requirements to neighbors for special use permits and re-zonings. Supervisor Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman English stated that these were good changes that would positively impact the process and give rural communities a bigger voice about the things that are going on around them.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

ACTION

Board of Supervisors

9. Adopt Resolution 17-21 dissolving the Babocomari Road and Traffic Signal Improvement District.

Mr. Britt Hanson, Chief Deputy County Attorney, presented this item. Mr. Hanson said that the main discussions had already been discussed in previous work sessions and went over the conditions of the resolution.

Chairman English said that this was the best solution at this time, but clarified that the County had been responsible for all associated costs and would be very careful in considering a road district in this community in the future.

Supervisor Judd moved to adopt Resolution 17-21 dissolving the Babocomari Road and Traffic Signal Improvement District. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

10. Approve the over-the-counter sale of tax deed properties as set forth in the attached Exhibit A, plus related administrative fees.

Approve the over-the-counter sales of tax deed properties remaining unsold following the May 2016 online tax deed land auction as set forth in the attached Exhibit A, plus related administrative fees.

Ms. Rios presented this item. She said that there had been one bid received for two parcels for a total sale of \$275 (\$200 for the bids and \$75 for the administrative fee). She added that the bids were lower than the minimum bid and the bidder had sited lack of utilities and difficult road access to both parcels.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to approve the over-the-counter sales of tax deed properties remaining unsold following the May 2016 online tax deed land auction as set forth in the attached Exhibit A, plus related administrative fees. Supervisor Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

County Schools

11. Approve the 2017-18 Odysseyware Pilot agreement for 50 licenses to be used in the Juvenile Detention Center and Small Schools Districts in Cochise County in the amount of \$1,617.

Ms. Rose Martinez, Chief Deputy, School Superintendent's Office, presented this item. Ms. Martinez went over the background and said that this program would benefit small school districts and juveniles in the County Juvenile Detention Center. She explained that Odysseyware is an online program to allow schools to facilitate instruction to their students and address shortage of staffing. She added that it also provides translation services and could also be used for those who are home schooled in the County to give them additional instruction.

Chairman English thanked Ms. Martinez and clarified that this was a pilot and this would give the County the opportunity to see if it really works.

Supervisor Judd moved to approve the 2017-18 Odysseyware Pilot agreement for 50 licenses to be used in the Juvenile Detention Center and Small Schools Districts in Cochise County in the amount of \$1,617. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

Information Technology

12. Approve Sub-License Agreement between Elfrida Fire District and T-Mobile West, LLC to place communication equipment on the Cochise County owned tower located on Elfrida Fire District property at 10295 N. Central Highway, Elfrida for the period of November 28, 2017 through November 27, 2027 with one additional 10-year option period.

Mr. Joe Casey, Information Technology Director, presented this item. Mr. Casey said that the County was acting as an intermediate and would not be impacted by this agreement. He added that Elfrida would still pay for half of the maintenance of the tower.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to Approve Sub-License Agreement between Elfrida Fire District and T-Mobile West, LLC to place communication equipment on the Cochise County owned tower located on Elfrida Fire District property at 10295 N. Central Highway, Elfrida for the period of November 28, 2017 through November 27, 2027 with one additional 10-year option period. Supervisor Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

13. Approve an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between Cochise County and the City of Tombstone regarding management, responsibility, technical support, computer replacement, security and access of the Tombstone Marshal to the Spillman Data System and Arizona Criminal Justice Information System for the period of November 28, 2017 through November 27, 2018, with four additional one year renewal options with an annual revenue of \$13,850 and a one-time revenue of \$3,250.

Mr. Joe Casey, Information Technology Director, presented this item. Mr. Casey said that the previous agreement had expired and this was a renewal agreement to formalize the partnership between the County and the City.

Supervisor Judd moved to approve an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between Cochise County and the City of Tombstone regarding management, responsibility, technical support, computer replacement, security and access of the Tombstone Marshal to the Spillman Data System and Arizona Criminal Justice Information System for the period of November 28, 2017 through November 27, 2018, with four additional one year renewal options with an annual revenue of \$13,850 and a one-time revenue of \$3,250. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

Procurement

14. Approve the award of Invitation for Bid 18-11-FAC-03 for the Cochise County Law Library renovation to B-R Constructors Inc. in the amount of \$84,600.

Ms. Maria Morales, Procurement Department, presented this item. Ms. Morales gave the background information and explained the review process.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to approve the award of Invitation for Bid 18-11-FAC-03 for the Cochise County Law Library renovation to B-R Constructors Inc. in the amount of \$84,600. Supervisor Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.
