1. Discussion and possible direction regarding Coronado Nat'l Forest Land and Resource Management Plan

Ms. Robinson announced that the Coronado National Forest Land and Resource Management Plan became effective on June 22nd and implementation began on July 23, 2018.

Ms. Robinson stated the goal of the plan is to provide strategic guidance and is made up of several major components. Some are the managing of fires, the eco system, and recreational sites for visitors. The plan is put together by the Forest Service with input from the public that included workshops and open houses. The plan fits in with the Coronado's National Forest vision in valuing places and people. Currently there are no changes to grazing, mining, or wilderness areas.
