**Board of Supervisors**

1. Discussion and possible direction regarding the County's Recycling Program with updates from the previous work session.

Mr. Haverty stated recyclables are not marketable in the County; he has met with the Rate Review Board, the City of Benson, the City of Sierra Vista, and the City of Douglas all of whom have voted that the County charge a fee for recycling.

Ms. Amanda Baillie presented a video titled "Leaner and Cleaner" as a possible public education tool. The video proposes that cardboard, tin, and plastics 1 and 2 will be accepted at all County dump stations at no cost and all other recyclables will be at a cost of \$64 per ton.

Supervisor Call suggested the suspension of the County's recycling program.

Supervisor English stated the Work Session is to determine if the County will continue to subsidize recycling.

The Board directed staff to keep the recycling program as is and requested another Work Session.

Chairman Judd adjourned the meeting at 3:26 p.m.
