

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

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***CALL TO THE PUBLIC***

Chairman Judd opened the call to the public.

Mr. Tom Crosby, Sierra Vista resident, addressed the Board regarding statute 11-217 and the Board's compliance.

No one else chose to speak and Chairman Judd closed the call to the public.

Ms. Daniella Reidmiller, Policy Manager, Health and Social Services, gave the background on the program and recognized both County employees that participated in the implementation and local organizations. They were each presented with a certificate by Ms. Carrie Langley, Health and Social Services Director.

The Board thanked everyone for their participation in these important programs for the wellness of the

community.

## **CONSENT**

### **Board of Supervisors**

1. Approve the Minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of April 9, 2019.

### **County Recorder**

2. Approve Voter Registration Services and Support Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between the Arizona Secretary of State's Office (SOS) and Cochise County, in the amount of \$8,039.19 effective, July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019.

### **County Schools**

3. Approve Memorandum of Agreement between Alliance of Arizona Nonprofits (AmeriCorps Vista) and the Cochise County School Superintendent to perform services to strengthen and supplement efforts to eliminate poverty-related human, social and environmental problems as specified in the Alliance AmeriCorps VISTA Project Application and Project Plan, in the amount of \$9,500, effective March 25, 2019 through March 25, 2020.

### **County Sheriff**

4. Approve Governor's Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) Contract 2019-CIOT-006 providing the Cochise County Sheriff's Office with \$6,000 to cover overtime expenses as well as employee related expenses, to participate in the two week "Buckle Up Arizona... It's the Law" program, effective, May 20, 2018 through June 2, 2018.
5. Approve Cooperative Service Agreement No.19-73-04-0228-RA between Cochise County and the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service and Wildlife Services, to assign a Wildlife Specialist to Cochise County for predator and disease control under the Wildlife Damage Management program to be conducted effective, July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.

### **Finance**

6. Approve demands and budget amendments for operating transfers. Warrants Nos. 33170-33400 were issued in the amount of \$1,384.373.26.

Pursuant to A.R.S. §11-217(C), the published minutes shall include all demands and warrants approved by the Board in excess of one thousand dollars except that multiple demands and warrants from a single supplier or individual under one thousand dollars whose cumulative total exceeds one thousand dollars in a single reporting period shall also be published. Issued warrants are listed as an attachment at the end of the minutes.

Vice-Chairman English moved to approve items 1-6 on the consent agenda. Chairman Judd seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

## **PUBLIC HEARING**

### **Elections**

7. Adopt Resolution 19-10 approving a consolidated schedule of fees and reimbursements for election services provided by the county and delegating authority to the County Administrator to execute intergovernmental agreements for election services.

Ms. Lisa Marra, Elections Director, presented this item. Ms. Marra gave the background on the item. She noted that the new fee schedule would go into effect on June 1, 2019. The fees are for people who use the county to conduct their elections. She showed the new fee schedule and noted that the County is only seeking to cover costs, not make a profit.

Chairman Judd opened the public hearing.

Mr. Tom Crosby, Sierra Vista resident, addressed the Board regarding his concerns.

No one else chose to speak and Chairman Judd closed the public hearing.

Vice-Chairman English moved to adopt 19-10 approving a consolidated schedule of fees and reimbursements for election services provided by the county and delegating authority to the County Administrator to execute intergovernmental agreements for election services. Chairman Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman Judd called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

## ***ACTION***

### **Board of Supervisors**

8. Approve Recreational Access Agreement to Assign Access to Whetstone Mountains/National Forest from the County to the Arizona Game and Fish Commission.

Chairman Judd removed item 8 from the agenda as requested by the County Attorney's Office. This item will be heard at a special meeting to be held on Monday, May 6, 2019 at 10:00 a.m.

### **County Schools**

9. Approve a Grant Agreement between the Cochise County School Superintendent's Office (CCSSO) and the Governor's Office, for a seventh grade drug prevention program in the amount of \$53,754, effective October 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019.

Ms. Jaqui Clay, County Schools Superintendent, presented this item. Ms. Clay explained that this was an administrative change to include changes made per Statute and the requirement of the Board to approve this new version.

Vice-Chairman English moved to approve a Grant Agreement between the Cochise County School Superintendent's Office (CCSSO) and the Governor's Office, for a seventh grade drug prevention program in the amount of \$53,754, effective October 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019. Chairman Judd seconded the motion.

Chairman Judd called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

### **County Sheriff**

10. Approve reoccurring contract for Stone Garden funding from the Department of Homeland Security (DOHS) in the amount of \$570,000 in overtime and mileage to participate in the operation to detect, deter and/or arrest subjects who smuggle humans or drugs illegally into the country; and \$917,052 for the purchase of additional equipment to assist in the mission to secure the border, effective April 1, 2019 through March 31, 2020.

Lieutenant Ken Foster, Sheriff's Office, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Lt. Foster went over the background, listed the benefits, highlighted some of the past purchases, and noted what the proposed funding would be used for. The two projects would focus on the improvement of radio communications and license plate readers countywide. He also shared statistics from criminal seizures and the positive economic impact on the County.

Vice-Chairman English asked questions about the requirements and reporting of the grant and noted that this grant was of concern to many government entities nationwide due to its impact to the Public Safety Personnel Retirement System's (PSPRS) unfunded liability.

Lt. Foster noted that the concerns regarding the retirement system were addressed by deploying deputies as part of the program that have less than ten years of service and whose salary and overtime have little impact on the unfunded liability.

Supervisor Borer asked about the radio coverage impact with the new resource. He also asked about all the capabilities available with the license plate reader.

Lt. Foster said that the new communication tool would assist with better radio reach and stated that license plate readers could be used for other purposes, like amber alerts.

Vice-Chairman English moved to approve reoccurring contract for Stone Garden funding from the Department of Homeland Security (DOHS) in the amount of \$570,000 in overtime and mileage to participate in the operation to detect, deter and/or arrest subjects who smuggle humans or drugs illegally into the country; and \$917,052 for the purchase of additional equipment to assist in the mission to secure the border, effective April 1, 2019 through March 31, 2020. Chairman Judd seconded the motion.

## **Health & Social Services**

11. Approve a one-time \$29,724 donation from the Arizona Community Foundation (ACF) for early screening and treatment for tuberculosis, effective April 15, 2019 through June 30, 2019.

Ms. Carrie Langley, Health and Social Services Director, presented this item. Ms. Langley thanked the Foundation and gave a background on the use of this donation for tuberculosis screening and treatment.

Vice-Chairman English moved to approve a one-time \$29,724 donation from the Arizona Community Foundation (ACF) for early screening and treatment for tuberculosis, effective April 15, 2019 through June 30, 2019. Chairman Judd seconded the motion.

The County was then presented with the check from a representative of the Arizona Community Foundation.

Chairman Judd called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

## **STATE & FEDERAL LEGISLATION**

12. Discussion and possible action regarding state and federal legislative matters listed or described in the attached County Supervisors Association Legislative Policy Committee Agenda, the Arizona Association of Counties (AACo) Legislative Policy Committee Agenda, and the proposed State budget, and other matters related thereto.

Vice-Chairman English went over the highlights and shared that nothing would be final until the State budget was approved by the Governor. The Board took no action.
