**Board of Supervisors**

1. Approve the Minutes of the October 13, 2020 and February 9, 2021 Flood Control District meetings.

Vice-Chairman Judd made a motion to approve item 1 on the Consent Agenda. Supervisor Crosby seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

### **Engineering & Natural Resources**

2. Approve an amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) among the Cochise County Flood Control District, City of Sierra Vista, City of Bisbee, Hereford Natural Resource Conservation District (NRCD) and The Nature Conservancy (TNC) to add Fort Huachuca as a partner to the established Cochise Conservation and Recharge Network.

Mr. Apel presented this item. He stated that this is an expansion of an MOU that the County Flood Control District entered into 2015 for the Cochise Conservation and Recharge Network; this amendment adds Fort Huachuca as a participating authority.

Supervisor Crosby distributed information to the Board, and discussed his opinion on, the San Pedro Riparian National Conservation Area (SPRNCA), and the Constitution of the United States and Arizona Revised Statutes, and stated that as SPRNCA is not listed in state statute as public land, a Recharge Network is not needed.

Vice-Chairman Judd made a motion to approve an amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) among the Cochise County Flood Control District, City of Sierra Vista, City of Bisbee, Hereford Natural Resource Conservation District (NRCD) and The Nature Conservancy (TNC) to add Fort Huachuca as a partner to the established Cochise Conservation and Recharge Network. Supervisor Crosby seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 2-1 (Crosby opposed).
