ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION

Board of Supervisors

1. Discussion and possible direction regarding the Flood Control District update.

Jackie Watkins presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Ms. Watkins provided updates on various projects, including the Leslie Canyon Pond project, where the county is collaborating with the Arizona Department of Water Resources. She stated another ongoing project is Bay Acres, aimed at reducing flooding, with design nearing completion and funding being pursued. Ms. Watkins discussion also touched upon initiatives like watershed studies and the Sulphur Springs Water Alliance, emphasizing collaboration among multiple stakeholders.

In response to the Board, Ms. Watkins stated there is a process for both installation and removal of the traffic speed humps, with decisions often based on residents' preferences and traffic studies conducted to assess the need.
