CALL TO THE PUBLIC

Randall Limbach urged the Board to consider a fiscally responsible bond for the jail project.

Robert McCormick thanked the Board for revisiting the bond issue.

Kara Harris called for a forensic audit, public discussion, and clear planning before any new jail bond is proposed.

Inga McCord urged the Board to use existing county land, develop clear jail requirements, and explore all funding options before considering new taxes.

Yvonne Mayer emphasized the need for clear details on the new jail's size, location, costs, and funding sources before any tax vote.
